Establishes Rule for Bantly Property at Manchester Green... The Board of Selectmen last night voted to establish a five-foot setback and building line on property owned by Ernest Bantly at the corner of East Center street and Middle Turnpike east, where the old Woodridge tavern formerly stood.

Attorney's Statement... Speaking for his client, Attorney Johnson said that his investigation has failed to show any way by which a change in property line would affect those who signed the petition, except possibly Mr. England.

As far as the traffic hazard is concerned, Johnson said he has never heard of any accident occurring at the corner in question although on a nearby open vision corner, many have taken place.

Attorney Rubinsow maintained that a line change will not serve the public interest and will prove to be a traffic danger and a danger to children crossing the street if a building is erected to extend out to the street corner.

After considering the question, the Board of Selectmen, with its chairman Cecil England, brother of W. Harry England, not voting, it was decided to adopt a compromise attitude whereby traffic danger would be reduced by the radius establishment, and a five-foot setback and veranda line would be set.

Bantly had pointed out that the plan would result in a new store and would oppose them if they went up for a liquor license. Bantly has asserted England's "trying to squeeze me out of this property."

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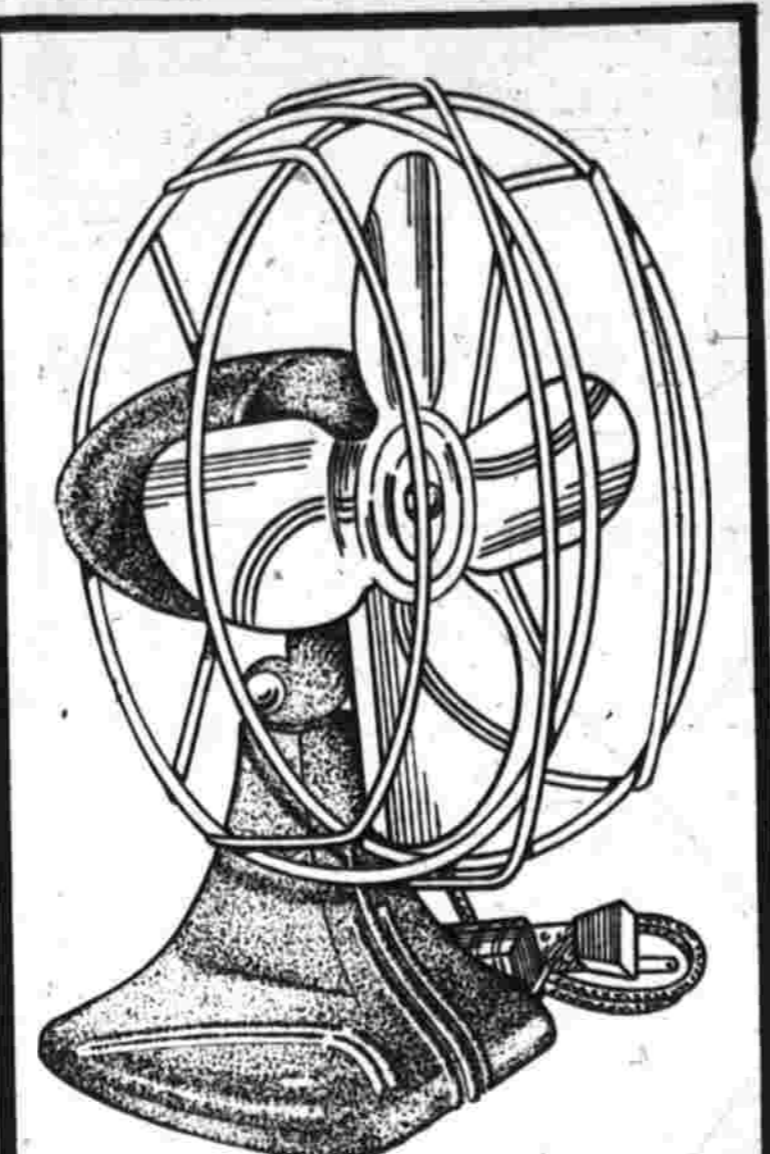
