Dewey Supports New Labor Law

Judge Condemns Bank's Low Pay
Detroit, July 18.—A Commonwealth bank employee who worked 15 years as a department head at \$200 a month today had a suspended sentence on an indictment charging that the bank had a reprimand from Federal Judge Frank A. Picard.
The judge accused bank officials of underpaying Arthur Alfred Craig, 42, and "dangling large sums of money" before the employee.
To Craig, who admitted taking \$2,500 during a two-year period by juggling records of service charges, Judge Picard said: "It is not surprising you are stealing. It is never justifiable."
But he added as he placed the defendant on two years' probation: "The bank informs me you were one of its best men. You worked late hours and appeared to have the bank's interest at heart. At the same time you were standing in the community if they expected you to wear a white shirt while they should pay you a white shirt salary."

Grabs Live Wire; Boy May Recover
Denver, July 18.—Clifton Spence, 12, was given a charge at Colorado General hospital today to recover from shock and burns after his small body was wracked nearly 10 minutes by 2,000 volts from a high tension wire.
Clifton, son of Mr. and Mrs. D. R. Spence of suburban Englewood, without instant electrocution until Harold Spence, also of Englewood, shoved his way through a frightened crowd of bystanders and kicked for wire out of the lady's clenched hand.
Englewood Fire Chief R. George Woods said the wire had fallen when a rodent gnawed through it and that young Spence, playing with three other boys, grabbed it. He was held over by the heavy current, Woods said the boy was held to the wire at least 10 minutes.

Floods Isolate Village
Shanghai, July 18.—Whole villages southeast of Canton are completely surrounded by flood waters, Miss Kay Booth, young American filer, reported from the Kwangtung province capital today. Thousands of victims, she said, were eating wild grass and roots after food supplies were lost.

Challenged Votes May Be Decisive
Milwaukee, July 18.—Production workers at the Allis-Chalmers Mfg. Co. will vote without a company-recognized bargaining agent today with the outcome of yesterday's election dependent upon 247 challenged votes.
The I.A.W.-C.I.O. Local 248, which last March ended a 328 day strike, without a contract piled up a margin of almost two to one over its nearest rival in the National Labor Relations board ballot, but the margin was 82 votes short of the required majority.
"The challenged ballots are sufficient to affect the results," Michael Esola of the Milwaukee NLRB office declared. He added that he was unable to say if a runoff election would be held or if the disputed ballots would receive a hearing.

Equipment to Be Set Up in Central Park Tomorrow Morning
