bombs and small arms fire. Only one bomb hit the camp and no casualties were reported.

Attacks were made against railroads in various parts of the Holy Land.

At Haifa, Tel Aviv and Jerusalem, mass demonstrations were held against deportation of the immigrants and Jews throughout Palestine held a general protest strike from 4 p. m. until 8 p. m.

In Haifa, nearly 15,000 persons attended the funeral of three Jews killed during the fighting between the Jewish and Arab forces.

A reliable source said that the 4,500 immigrants aboard the Exodus of 1947 were being shipped back to France and "new" long-term approach to the handling of such blockade runners.

These informants who cannot be identified by name, said the 4,500 or more aboard the craft from the Ant-Fascist People's Freedom League, were being transported in three British deportation ships to their port of embarkation, Sete, near Marseille.

However, British Foreign and Colonial office spokesmen refused comment.

The informants said the Jews returned to France presumably were to be accommodated in displaced persons' camps.

Britain has been in touch with "certain" European countries on the whole question of Jewish immigration to the Holy Land, they said, and arrangements have been made with at least Italy and France to halt the flow of European Jews without immigration certificates by returning them to their own countries.

This course long has been advocated by the Arab leaders here.

In recent months Jews arriving in Palestine about the quota have been sent to detention camps in Cyprus.
