Denies Price Markup Big

Hartford, Aug. 28.—Farmers' charges of exorbitant mark-ups by retailers who buy their produce are "unfounded with respect to the Hartford area," says Andrew E. Reilly, president of the Hartford County Farmers' Market association.

Reilly issued a statement last night after a day spent checking the reaction of members of his association to a resolution adopted Tuesday at a meeting of the Connecticut Farm Bureau federation in which the farmers placed the blame for high food prices wholly upon retailers.

Rally referred to specific charges made by Clarence F. Baldwin, president of the New Haven County Farm bureau, that corn brought 75 cents a hundred ears wholesale and sold for 35 cents a dozen retail; and by L. Lee Bacon, president of the Hartford County Farm bureau, that tomatoes for which growers got 50 cents per 27-pound basket sold for 10 cents a pound.

"What Mr. Baldwin failed to mention, although it must be known to him," said Reilly, "is that there is a wide variance in quality between first grade produce and low-grade merchandise. When he mentions corn retailing for 35 cents a dozen, when it was selling wholesale for 75 cents a hundred, he created a false impression that he was referring to the same quality of merchandise in both examples. Actually, corn of an inferior grade has been sold in local member stores for as low as 10 cents a dozen, but the merchant was not offering it or pricing it as first-class merchandise. The same thing holds true for tomatoes."

Clears Ruling On Auto Sales

New Procedure on Registration Transferred Is in Effect Tuesday

Hartford, Aug. 28.—State Tax Commissioner Walter W. Walsh said Motor Vehicle Commissioner Elmer S. Watson today released information on the new procedure to be followed on and after Tuesday, September 2 by all persons making application for original or transferred registrations of motor vehicles in Connecticut.

The Sales and Use Tax Act requires that proof of payment of sales tax be furnished to the Motor Vehicle Commissioner before an original or transferred registration may be issued for a motor vehicle.

When new or used cars are sold by dealers, they will collect the sales tax from the purchaser in all cases, except exempt transactions at the time of sale.

Persons who received their cars as gifts or who purchased them from persons not in the business of selling motor vehicles (casual sales), are not required to pay a sales tax. Sales to religious and charitable organizations, as well as to the United States, the State and their political subdivisions, are also exempt from sales tax.

Helicopter Flying Here Crashes; No One Hurt

Two in Machine When It Drops in East Hartford; Was Handed for Ford's Orchards

A helicopter owned by the Air Crop-Dusting Service, Inc., of Hartford, which had contracted to dust from the air seven acres of peach trees owned by Joseph Ford on his farm on Avery street in South Windsor, crashed this morning in the Whitaker Marine Company boatyard on Riverside drive in East Hartford.

The cause of the crash is directly across the Connecticut river from the Whitaker boatyard where the helicopter was based. Neither the pilot, John Gibson, of Meriden, Conn., or the hand of the company, Eugene E. Card, Jr., of 21 Outlook street, East Hartford, were hurt in the crash which badly damaged the aircraft.

The pilot of the 'copter stated that he would arrange to have his crop dusted by the company from his light plane, which he said would not be as effective in his situation, but which would afford some protection to his crop.

Mr. Card stated this morning that his helicopter was covered by insurance, but that he expected that he would not have the use of it, or a new 'copter if the damage was so great as to make the old one irreparable for the remainder of the dusting season.

The helicopter which was manufactured by the Bell Helicopter Corporation was valued at \$25,000. The pilot of the craft had been trained to fly the helicopter at the Bell Corporation School.

The crash which happened at 10:30 a. m. at the boatyard, caused the loss of power to the rotor. The pilot said that he headed directly into the cut in the trees lining the bank caused by the wreckage and tree limbs. He indicated that the rotor blades had struck trees before the craft came to a rest on the ground. The pilot and passenger could not see the morning fog and the pilot was unable to see the ground.
