The Greenland Question

Whether or not the United States should preempt, by plain military force and diplomatic ruthlessness, a few military bases in the generally barren wastes of Denmark's Greenland is perhaps, in the world maelstrom of today, a relatively unimportant question.

It is because it is a symbolic test of America's loyalty to its own principles that it keeps cropping out from beneath the smooth and silent treatment it is getting from official Washington.

The same story also said definitely, for the first time, that Denmark formally asked the United States last May to open negotiations "at the earliest possible date" for termination of the 1941 agreement by which the United States originally established its military bases on Greenland.

Does the United States, in response to the desires of its Army officials, intend to keep its bases in Greenland regardless of what Denmark thinks? Does this country now practice the theory that might makes right? Does our traditional and much-talked respect for the sovereignty of other nations dwindle and disappear when we happen to want something ourselves? What we actually do about Greenland with Denmark will tell us a lot about ourselves, and tell the world a lot about us too.

Recreating The Dust Bowl

Thirteen years ago, this country was suffering its great dust bowl tragedy. Vast stretches of once fertile farming land were converted into desert when one of the weather man's periodic droughts happened to withhold the normal moisture which keeps soil settled in its place.

After the tragedy came, the government and the nation's farm interests undertook an ambitious program of correction. We devised anti-erosion techniques. We planted strips of green trees. We originated a system for the rotational use of land, so that some of the soil would always be securely anchored while the rest was being cultivated.

again, and there was a general assumption that never again would we expose ourselves to such tragedy.

Now, from all reports from the plains states, we are busy making ourselves a bigger and more tragic dust bowl. We are doing it by discarding all the safe practices we learned back in 1934.

The plains states are full of "suitcase" exploiters of the soil, who hire or buy marginal land cheaply, exploit it for the two or three years in which it will now produce a rich crop, and then move on, leaving it in supremely dangerous condition.

Such absentee speculators are not alone. Established farmers, even some of those who knew the tragedy of the previous dust bowl, are throwing caution to the winds as they see grain prices rising.

But tomorrow, given an unfavorable turn in the weather cycle, the dust winds may blow. If they do blow, they will blow on the just and the unjust, those who farmed wisely and those who farmed ruthlessly, those who did learn the lesson of 1934 and those who refused to learn it.

"Never again," said everybody, very fervently, back in 1934. Wave a thousand dollar bill, thirteen years later, and we start repeating the greatest mistake in the history of our country, this time after we have every reason to know just how tragic a mistake it is.

World Trade Charter. On the good side of the world ledger, along with things like the freedom of India, the solid work of many UN suborganizations whom the veto never touches, and all the other good instincts and policies which may help this world toward a permanent and stable peace if only it can avoid rushing into the last war, must be placed the writing of a new world trade charter by the United Nations Conference on Trade and Unemployment at Geneva.

This charter still has to be accepted formally by the 17 nations whose representatives drew it. Translating its principles into a real agreement on tariffs will be another great and difficult hurdle.

A hotel key in a pocket of the man's clothes enabled police to trace the middle-aged victim to a San Francisco hotel (The Whitcomb), where he had been registered under the name of "J. P. Brown." However, the trail was lost there, for he had given a fictitious New Jersey address (121 Clinton street).

The man's throat had been slashed three times. Labels had been torn from his expensive suit, his shirt and his underclothing. The victim apparently had been dead about ten hours.

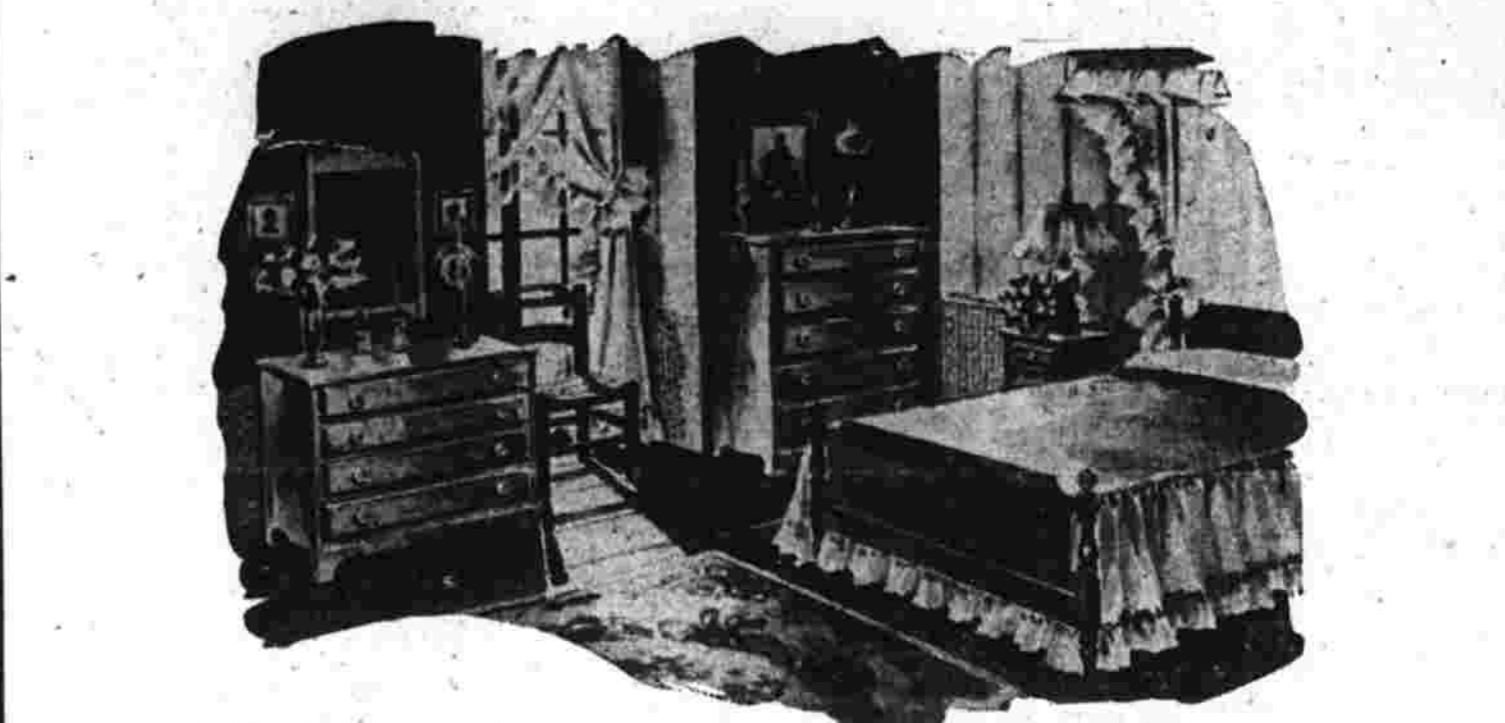

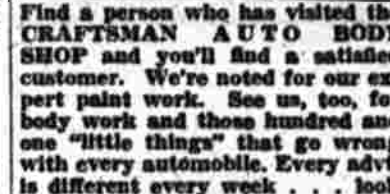

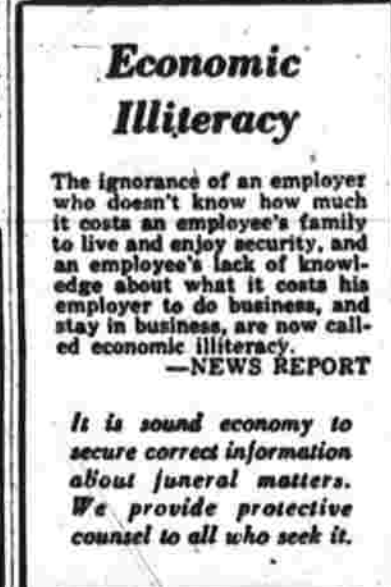
