Two Trustees Being Sought

Escape from Windham County Jail Yards Mixed at Muster

Brooklyn, Sept. 19.—Two trustees at the Windham county jail, who had been inmates of that institution less than a week, were sought by police officers at a muster search today following their escape from the jail yards, the fifth escape from the jail in about a year.

The missing prisoners were identified by Sheriff James Politer as George F. Koch, 23, of Webster, Mass., and Donald Paul of Danvers, Mass. Police said the men disappeared some time after noon yesterday when they were working unguarded in the yard. Their absence was noted by Deputy Jailer Raymond Vielle at the regular afternoon muster of prisoners. Police said he was attending a meeting at the Windham county commissioners' at Danvers at the time.

State police notified immediately and Capt. Leo J. Mutchy of the Orangeville division commander, took immediate charge of the search. He assigned the entire staff of the Danvers barracks and additional men from Stafford Springs, Colchester and the Westport barracks, besides alerting Massachusetts and Rhode Island state police.

Describing the search, Mutchy said that all eastern Connecticut roads were searched for the fugitives. Roadblocks were established at bridges over the Connecticut river at Hartford, Plainfield and Old Lyme.

Both men, said Politer, were sentenced to the jail on Sept. 12 by the Windham county Superior court session at Putnam and were brought to the institution that day. Both, he said, had previous jail records.

Koch, he said, originally had been sentenced to a year in jail on charges of taking a motor vehicle without the owner's permission three months. This time he was sentenced to serve six months on a similar charge in addition to charges of operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of liquor and operating a motor vehicle while his operator's license was suspended. He also was sentenced to serve the remainder of his original sentence.

Policing, who previously had served a term of six months for assault in Danvers, was serving a term of six months for taking a motor vehicle without the owner's permission.

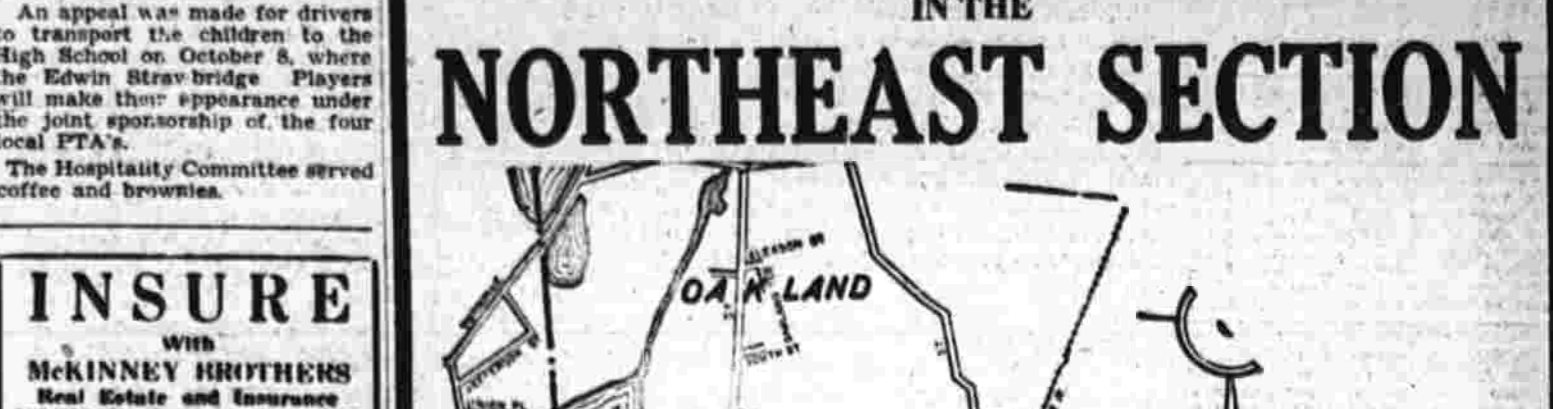
