**Two Staples Of Diet Rise Near Peaks**

**Meat and Wheat Continue to Go Up in Leading Markets; Hints Of Drastic Steps**

By The Associated Press

Prices of meat and wheat—two staples of the American diet—continued to rise to near record peaks in leading markets today as President Truman's drive for "self-rationing" to conserve grain for Europe went into high gear.

There were hints the administration might take more drastic steps if necessary—such as price control and compulsory rationing.

Live hogs at Chicago climbed for the fourth straight day and topped at \$30.25 a hundred pounds early in the market that was 25 to 30 cents higher. The top was within 25 cents of the all-time peak reached last Sept. 11.

The average price of hogs yesterday soared 92 cents to a record high of \$29.75. The previous high was \$28.75, reached Feb. 25.

#### Monthly Report of Center Shows Visits of 648 Ex-Servicemen

The 648 veterans who visited the Service Center during September made 718 separate requests for help in information, according to an announcement made today by Director Nathan B. Gatchell in connection with the release of the monthly report of activities.

The present period in veterans' service programs is expected to show a sharp decline in demands. This has not yet materialized in Manchester. The Center was not open on Labor Day; hence if 35 contacts, normal for the first of the month, had been made, the total for the month would have been 683, the highest since August.

His going leaves a gap in the service which cannot be filled locally. His work will be carried on by Howard S. Place on Mondays and Fridays.
