Police Charge Mobs In Heart of Rome; Chant Red Anthem

Quickly Clear Crowds From Their Concentration Point Below Windows of Italian Foreign Office; General Strike Appears to Have Loosened Grip As Settlement Sought

Rome, Dec. 12.—(AP)—Jewish mobs, riot squads, swinging clubs, charged, surging crowds today in the heart of strike-bound Rome, as they chanted the Communist anthem "Red Flag." Police quickly cleared the crowds, in the Piazza Colonna, from their concentration point below the windows of the Italian Foreign Office. The crowd gave way, jeering and boisterous.

Two Photographers Struck. Two Associated Press photographers from the United States, Walter Green and Frank Noel, were struck by a mob of young men, but suffered no serious injury. They continued working, after identifying themselves.

Rome's general strike, now in its second day, appears to have loosened its grip somewhat, despite the determination of the Communist-controlled Chamber of Labor to pursue it to the bitter end. The strike has weakened the strikers' effectiveness as Premier Alcide De Gasperi's Christian Democrats have pressed for a settlement.

The most vigorous public action was at the Piazza Colonna, where leftists were angered and embittered. At one point, Pietro Nenni, the leader of the Socialist Proletarian wing, and Giuseppe Pajetta, a Communist member of the Constituent Assembly, were seized in a frame-up attempt to remonstrate with police. Neither was injured.


