Suit Will Test Board Powers

Issue Regarding Boards of Finance May Go To Supreme Court

Hartford, Dec. 17.—(AP)—A suit testing whether a municipal Board of Finance can refuse to appropriate funds for salary increases voted teachers by the Board of Education has been argued in the Superior Court here.

Lawyers said the issue probably would be carried to the State Supreme court.

The case was brought on behalf of 15 employees of the Enfield school system, who were voted salary increases of \$200 early this year by the Board of Education in a move to avert a possible strike.

The employees have received \$100 of the increase, but complained that the Board of Finance has taken no action to appropriate funds needed to pay the balance.

Relative Powers Source of Dispute

The relative powers of Boards of Finance and Boards of Education has been a source of dispute in many Connecticut municipalities.

The Supreme court has decided one case on the issue, ruling in the so-called Groton case that Boards of Education have the power, regarding Boards of Finance, to carry out duties imposed on them by law.

Counsel in the Enfield case said yesterday, however, that the Groton case involved transportation for pupils and that the Supreme court has made no direct ruling on whether the Board of Finance must supply funds for increased salaries.

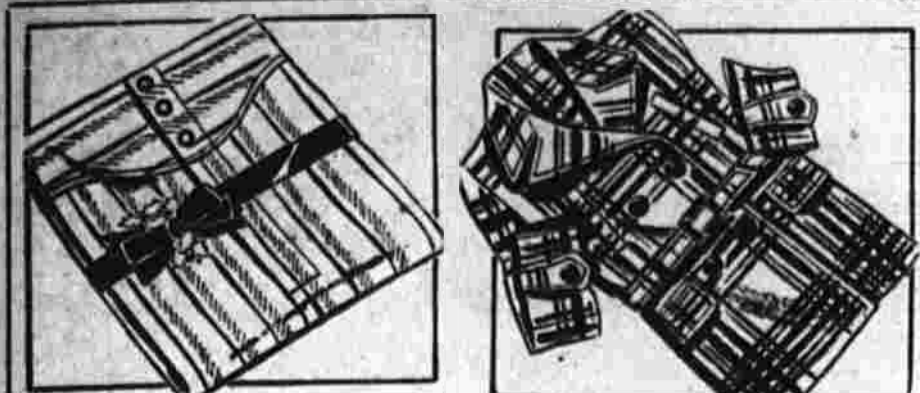
To approve and authorize a superseding School Building Committee consisting of seven members, three of which shall be the Board of Selectmen, two which shall be appointed by the Board of Education, and two of which to be appointed by the Board of Finance.

To authorize such superseding School Building Committee to secure plans and specifications for the construction of an elementary school building, in accordance with the provisions of Section 208c of the 1935 Supplement to the Connecticut General Statutes, on the newly acquired site, at a cost not exceeding \$150,000.00, including the suitable furnishing and equipping thereof.

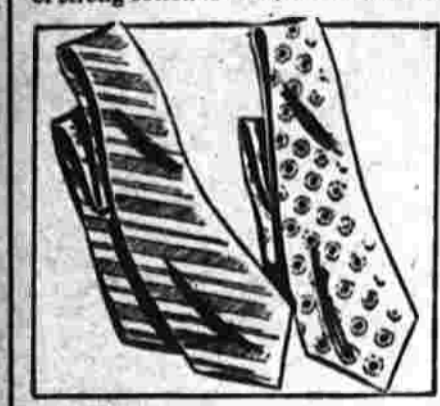

Rockville Building Code For Rockville

Rockville, Dec. 17.—(Special)—The adoption of the building code and amendments as recommended by the state effective as of Dec. 28 was the principal item of business at the meeting of the Common Council held Tuesday evening with Mayor Raymond C. Thum presiding. The building code had been a lengthy discussion with various members of the Council participating. Alderman Fred Berge, who is mayor-elect, stated that while he was in favor of a building code, he would like more information and suggested a public hearing. Alderman Kenneth Smith stated that he had read only a portion of the building code and found many questions in his mind as to the designated height of ceilings, specifications for attached garages, outside entrances and the like.

At this point, Alderman Kurt Berthold spoke in favor of the adoption, explaining that if sufficient number of towns adopt the code it will be mandatory by the state. Alderman Berthold stated that this is one of the most important steps to be taken by the city of Rockville and strongly urged the members to act favorably. He cited the dangers of fire, saying that the City Fire Marshal, who strictly enforces regulations. Alderman Berthold reminded the Council of the circus fire, being one of those present. Alderman William Dowling spoke in favor of the resolution being adopted.

Corporation Counsel Harry H. Lutz explained that the code would be applicable to future building and alterations and that in his opinion present buildings would not be affected. He stated that in his opinion it was most important for the progress of the city.

Speaking as a contractor, Alderman John Bottier told the Council that most of the building contractors of the city were in favor of the code's adoption, and he felt that any minor paragraphs which did not apply to Rockville could be amended. Alderman J. Doherty asked for information in regard to qualifications and salary of a building inspector as recommended. Following a short discussion in regard to these items, it

was voted to adopt the State Building Code. Four petitions were granted. A. K. Pillsbury to demolish partially burned house on Pillsbury Hill; Peter Genovesi for garage attached to house and driveway at Pine street; Herbert Pagan for addition to garage, 1920 at 15 King street; Rev. George S. Brooker to demolish barn and attached coop at 103 Union street.

Upon the recommendation of Alderman Samuel Gander, the mayor was authorized to sign a contract for the collection of garbage for the coming year with the approval of the Health Committee and the Corporation Council.

The Council adopted a resolution relating salaries of the Police Department to be as follows: Per day, Captain, \$8.00; Sergeant, \$5.50; Patrolmen, \$4.00. Super numeraries, \$7.10; 14 days vacation with pay for men on the force at least five years; 7 days vacation with pay for those on the force less than 5 years, effective Dec. 28, 1947.

Several Democratic Aldermen were present at last night's session of the Council.

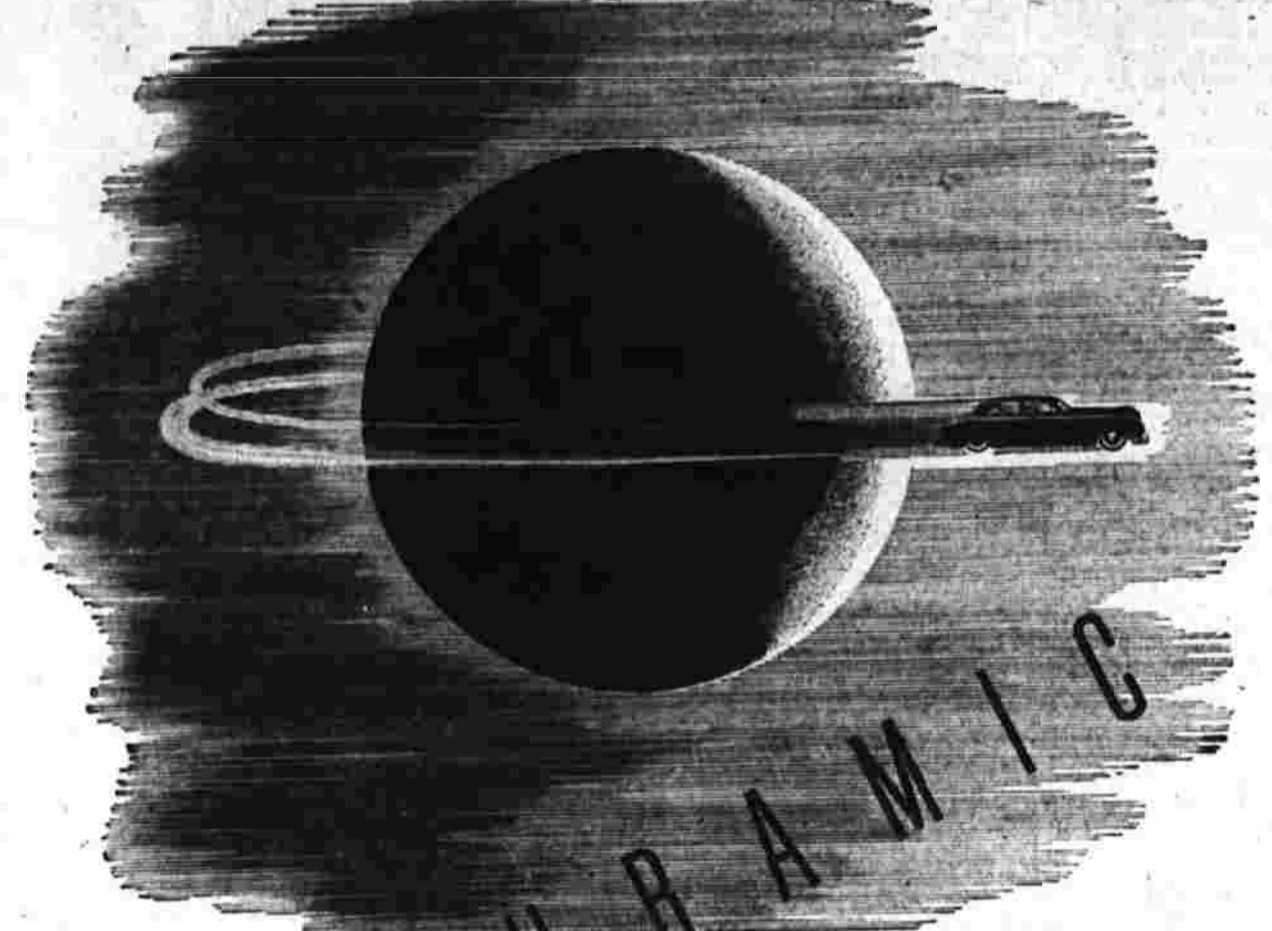

Hamilton Prop On New Planes

U. S. Navy Picks It For the Albatross; Its Features

Hamilton standard Hydromatic propellers have been selected for the U. S. Navy's newest amphibious utility airplane, the Grumman XJREP Albatross, according to word from the Navy Department. The Hydromatic used are light weight versions of the standard three-bladed commercial propeller and are 11 feet in diameter.

The Albatross is a twin engine plane designed for rough-water operation on its open sea, in rescue work, personnel or cargo transport or multi-engine seaplane training. Operated by a crew of three, it can carry 14 passengers in rescue operations or more than 400 pounds of cargo. Capable of a maximum range of 2600 miles, the Albatross will cruise 1400 miles as a cargo hauler and 800 miles when loaded with rescued personnel. It has a cruising speed of 235 miles per hour and a maximum speed of 270 miles per hour. Boasting a wing span of 80 feet

and fuselage length of 41 feet, the Albatross is expected to take over some of the present non-combatant duties of the obsolescent PVY Cat.
