We Reprint an Editorial
We are reprinting, below, an
editorial, "A Speech for the President,"
which first ran on this page Saturday.

We want to emphasize our own
belief in it.

We want to discuss it some
more.

We want to have other people
discuss it, and use their own logic
in testing it. If they find it good,
we hope they will pass it on to
others.

This procedure on our part re-
flects not only our own conviction,
but also a rather remarkable re-
sponse to the editorial which oc-
curred over the weekend.

There is no personal vanity in-
volved, since the original editorial
was the result of a collaboration
between two staff members. Dis-
agreeing in their interpretation of
many of the surface aspects of the
present world situation, they found
themselves agreed on one
fundamental solution.

What is involved is a certain
possibility, a chance.

It is the chance that this particu-
lar editorial has happened to say
something fundamental.

It is the chance that this pro-
posed speech by the President of
the United States is a statement
of one fundamental policy which
might prove to answer a sur-
prising number of the world's very
complex problems.

It is the chance that it may be,
in its timely way, and after it has
perhaps been taken up and im-
proved by others, a preamble to
peace with honor, peace without
appeasement.

We ask our readers to see what
it suggests to them.

Particularly, we suggest that
readers select what seems to them
the most complicated and trouble-
some and unworkable of all the
world's problems, and see, in their
own minds, what a carrying out
of the proposed presidential policy
would do to these problems.

In an accompanying editorial
Saturday, we applied this pro-
posed policy to the situation in
Greece and Czechoslovakia.

Try it on China, on Palestine,
or on Germany.

Finally, try it on the biggest
problem of all, the problem of
Russian-American relations.

Then see whether or not you
agree that if this one policy could
be carried out, all other problems
would either disappear or resolve
themselves, or be settled in a new
kind of world relationship, in
which diplomats brought no threat
of guns to the conference table.

If our readers come to this far,
they are then going to ask them-
selves one important question—
"Can't they sell this?" We can see
that such a policy would work.
But would Russia go along with
it?

We have asked ourselves that
question, too, and say this:
Let Russia herself answer.
No American can answer for
her.

No American can pretend to
know what Russia would say.
If the proposed policy is good,
it is not our task to answer for
Russia, but to answer for our-
selves.

Will America accept this pol-
icy?
World problems grow bigger.
They grow more complicated.
They grow more hopeless.
The hearts of men grow heavier.
Billions of human beings are
close to the final fearful sur-
render.

Genlemen:
We completed the fighting, two
and a half years ago, of a World
War. The United States fought
in that war against the forces of
ruthless military aggression,

We fought for liberty among
men; for a reign of law and jus-

Today, we stand in danger of a
misapplication of the military
power we generated on behalf of
those issues.

The world, long and recurrently

of one fundamental policy which
might prove to answer a sur-
prising number of the world's very
complex problems.

It is the chance that it may be,
in its timely way, and after it has
perhaps been taken up and im-
proved by others, a preamble to
peace with honor, peace without
appeasement.

We ask our readers to see what
it suggests to them.

Particularly, we suggest that
readers select what seems to them
the most complicated and trouble-
some and unworkable of all the
world's problems, and see, in their
own minds, what a carrying out
of the proposed presidential policy
would do to these problems.

In an accompanying editorial
Saturday, we applied this pro-
posed policy to the situation in
Greece and Czechoslovakia.

Try it on China, on Palestine,
or on Germany.

Finally, try it on the biggest
problem of all, the problem of
Russian-American relations.

Then see whether or not you
agree that if this one policy could
be carried out, all other problems
would either disappear or resolve
themselves, or be settled in a new
kind of world relationship, in
which diplomats brought no threat
of guns to the conference table.

If our readers come to this far,
they are then going to ask them-
selves one important question—
"Can't they sell this?" We can see
that such a policy would work.
But would Russia go along with
it?

We have asked ourselves that
question, too, and say this:
Let Russia herself answer.
No American can answer for
her.

No American can pretend to
know what Russia would say.
If the proposed policy is good,
it is not our task to answer for
Russia, but to answer for our-
selves.

"Prison Labor"
To Build Barn

Zeller Announces De-
cision Regarding Replac-
ing Structure Burned

Hartford, March 22.—(AP)—Con-
necticut will use "prison labor" to
construct a new barn at Os-
born Prison farm.

Comptroller Fred R. Zeller, in
announcing the decision today,
said the move was made because
the state had "sufficient money"
available for a private contract.

Through use of penal inmate
labor, he said, the barn, to replace
the old structure which was burned
last fall, can be constructed "for
less than \$50,000." He said the in-
surance money from the destroyed
building will just about cover the
cost.

If an award were made to a pri-
vate contractor, the total cost
would probably be more than
\$125,000," Mr. Zeller estimated.

The comptroller will see that
the insurance money is used for
the construction, erection, alter-
ation, repair or enlargement of any
structure in the necessary manner.

This can be done "without the ne-
cessary use of inmate labor," he
said.

Called "Rehabilitation" Measure
In addition to "moving taxpayers'
money" out of the state treasury,
the measure will serve as a "rehabilita-
tion" measure.

Present plans call for the huge
barn to be built over the founda-
tion of the burned structure, mak-
ing possible "another saving of
money."

Although the state was virtually
"forced" to solve the building
problem in this manner, Mr. Zeller
feels the idea will meet
with general approval of taxpayers
who may soon be asked to con-
tribute in special installments. He
indicated, however, that the
state was not necessarily commit-
ting itself to any such measure.
