### 90,000 Trout Await Hooks

200,000 More to Be Released by State Before Season Ends

Hartford, April 14.—(C) Connecticut trout fishermen will find, or try to find, 90,000 speckled beauties waiting for them when the season opens next Saturday, according to Dr. Russell P. Hunter, superintendent of the Board of Fisheries and Game.

What's more 200,000 additional "cultivated" trout will be released in state waters between opening day and the end of June. The trout, distributed and to be distributed, are not fingerlings. Dr. Hunter said. The fish are all from 8 to 12 inches in length and the largest of them weigh more than half-a-pound.

Size of catch cut. To insure a fair distribution of the 200,000 trout, the fisheries board has cut from 10 to six the number of trout which can be taken from any state-regulated stream. The new rule also has to do with the weight of the angler's catch. It specifies that six trout, or a catch of trout weighing not more than five pounds and one trout in addition to such a catch, may be taken in one day from any state-regulated stream.

The rule does not specify whether the angler or the game ward will carry a scale capable of weighing up to five pounds. In non-regulated streams, 10 trout, or not more than five pounds and one trout, may be taken in one day.

Legal length unchanged. The legal length for brook trout remains at six inches and the limit for lake trout, a species found only in Warrenburg lake, New Preston, and West Twin lake in Salisbury, is 15 inches. Only three lake trout can be legally taken in a day.

The season opens in all streams and most regulated trout ponds Saturday. Closing date is July 15. The board has authority to extend the season if conditions warrant.
