Strike Fund Drive Starts

Campaign to Assess United Electrical Workers Under Way Now

Hartford, May 21—(AP)—A campaign for a \$1 million strike fund is under way in the ranks of 35,000 United Electrical Workers members under way today.

This was voted by officials of the union Thursday night at the Italian-American home.

Employees of Colt Mfg. company and American Hardware company, New Britain, were mentioned as possible beneficiaries of the fund.

The UE plans walkouts at the hardware company sometime after June 2 and possibly at Colt sometime after June 27.

Two possible strikes would be recognized. Companies have refused to deal with their UE local after contracts expire.

Solidarity demonstrators theme of last night's conference led by UE District President Paul Raymond was solidarity. Speakers cited need for solid union front to win any recognition fight.

It was said the strike fund is not for union members but for union permitted its possible use for any union member who goes on strike.

AFI teamsters striking against Bryant and Chapman at 11 P. M. G. Miller companies were cited as possible beneficiaries of the fund.

The conference attended by 200 officials was called for wage discussions. International Order of Iron Workers said wage demands made on some of the companies with UE unions.

Will Work Pattern

Wage negotiations he said will be opened as soon as possible with "realistic" demands.

Consequent increases Barry said will form pattern for demands on less vulnerable companies.

"Vulnerable" companies he said are those in highly competitive markets.

Resolution on the "wage struggle in the Hartford area" was adopted. It stresses the need of more money.

Leaders of the recent movement called the strike into United Automobile Workers were termed "traitors" who hamper the wage drive.

Mundt Bill Attached

The Mundt bill to control Communism was reportedly attacked during the conference.

Barry called for a public relations campaign to tell the public that labor troubles occur. It will be the fault of the companies and not of the unions.

Firms Seek Locations For Business in State

The Connecticut Development Commission has issued a list of manufacturing enterprises which are seeking locations for their businesses in Connecticut. The list has been compiled with notation of the type of business, area required, whether or not a railroad siding is desired, the preferred section of the state in which location is desired, and a column of additional remarks.

For instance, a worsted firm wants 10 to 20 thousand square feet of space, with a railroad siding, in the southeastern part of the state, with a railroad siding, 2,000 feet near Hartford. A pencil and crayon manufacturer wants 20,000 square feet of space, with one or two story building of 20 to 25 thousand feet.

A textile, plating and acetate firm wants 15 to 20 thousand feet in a town of not over 50 thousand population. And a chemicals company wants 200 thousand feet with a railroad siding near a large river.

A check printing establishment desires five thousand feet near a post office and on the ground floor. Greeting card manufacturers want 25 to 30 thousand feet in a town of not over 50 thousand population.

Miss Gwiltner has resigned as an Associate Editor of The Christian Science Journal, The Christian Science Sentinel, and The Herald of Christian Science in its several editions.

Miss Gwiltner is a native of New York, where her mother, Mrs. Lucy L. Gwiltner, C. S. B., practiced and taught Christian Science. She united with The Mother Church in New York City, where her graduation from high school she spent a year in the study of languages, after which she returned to the United States and studied at the Musical Art Institute in New York City, from which she was graduated in 1915.

Miss Gwiltner became active in her practice in 1918 and was a member of the Christian Science Journal as a practitioner in 1922. In 1940, she was a member of the Normal class of the Board of Education, thereupon becoming an authorized teacher of Christian Science.

Hearing Set On Petition

New Haven Road Asks Permission to Seek Refund on Interest

New Haven, May 21—(AP)—The Federal District court here has set for June 14, at 1 P. M. (a. t. m.), the date for hearing a petition by the New Haven, New Haven and Hartford railroad for permission to institute proceedings against the Reconstruction Finance Corporation for \$90,844.

The money is sought as a refund on interest on loans totaling \$12,480,000 made to the New Haven road by the RFC between 1933 and 1935, when the railroad went into receivership, which it emerged last September.

The railroad contends that it had a promise from H. Jones, when he was RFC chairman, to reduce the interest on the loans from five to four per cent, and that the RFC later repudiated the alleged agreement.

"Jones' Interest Paid" The railroad says it paid the RFC \$270,287 in "interest" also made a payment of \$483,407 upon its discharge from bankruptcy.
