Temperatures in the warm belt yesterday ranged from around the 100 mark in the Gulf region to 90 and above at some cities as far north as northern Iowa. Admits Killing Dixie Soldier

Mystery Solved by Confession of Bridgeport Machinist

Savannah, Ga., June 11.—The mystery surrounding the slaying of a 28-year-old Georgia soldier has been solved by the confession of a New England machinist, the Georgia Bureau of Investigation reported last night.

The New Englander, 27-year-old George P. Wheeler of Bridgeport, Conn., admitted in a signed statement made in a jail cell at Savannah, Ga., with a stout piece of wood and later dragged his body onto railroad tracks near Savanah.

Wheeler's statement said the besting took place on May 24, five days later McMullan's remains were found strewn along the tracks. Relatives told authorities they had not missed the soldier because they believed he was on his way to begin a re-enlistment at New Brunswick, N. J.
