

U. S. authorities started flying drugs into the city to fight the squeeze, which took the form of a rail freight blockade and a cessation of food and brown coal supplies from the surrounding Russian zone.

The Americans also announced plans to fly in powered and condensed milk for German bables. Supplies of fresh milk have been shut eff with other food supplies for some 2,000,000 Berliners in the city's western sectors. A barge was reported to have arrived from western Germany with grain and flour today, but there was no sign of a letup of the land embargo.

The Allied announcement on money changing said half the converted deutsche marks will be credited to a "free deutsche mark account" for immediate use. How many will be converted is not yet known as the Germans had until noon today to file statements of their holdings. The other half will go into a "blocked deutsche mark account" and will be released as economic conditions permit.

The old marks may be exchanged for new only if they were duly reported on the proper forms since the currency reform was announced a week ago.




