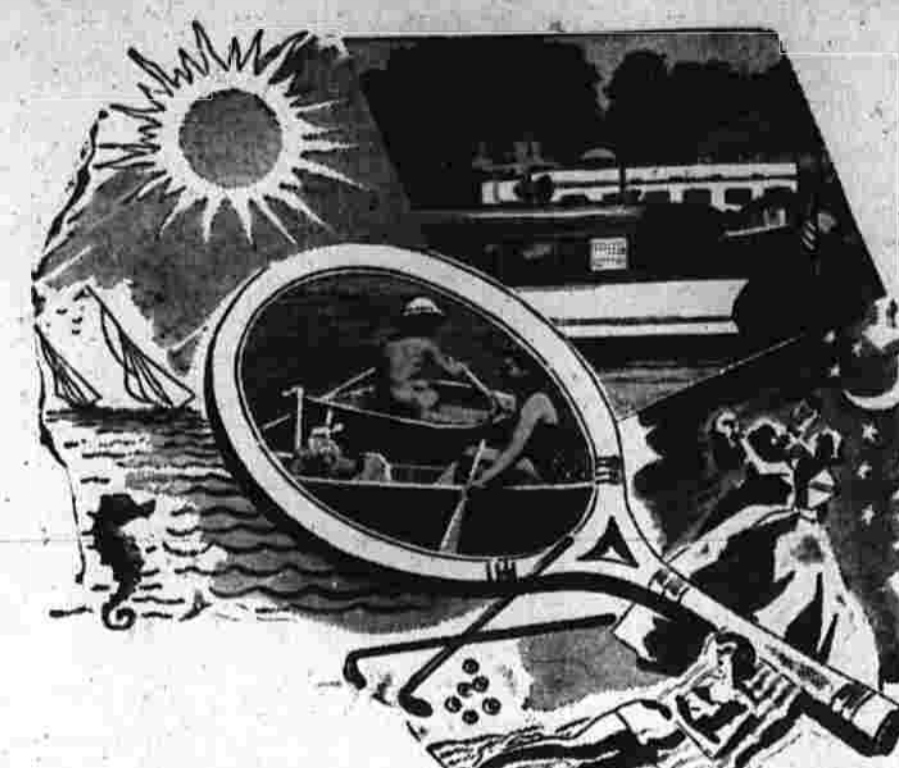

Start State Soil Survey Detailed Work Beginning to Chart Areas; At Windsor First

New Haven, July 17—The first detailed soil survey of Connecticut got underway this week with work beginning near Windsor. Dr. C. L. W. Swanson, soils department head at the Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station, who is in charge of the project, says that the survey will be conducted by county, Hartford County, with the largest area of tillable land, having been selected as the initial one.

The soil survey, which Dr. Swanson says is the longest conducted in this State, is being conducted by the Soil Conservation Service, with the Soil Survey Division and the Soil Conservation Service of the United States Department of Agriculture cooperating. Dr. Swanson heads the administrative part of the program, which is assisted by W. H. Lyford of the Soil Survey Division and C. W. R. Brown of the Soil Conservation Service. Men doing the field work are Nicholas Holroydeyck, Soil Survey Division; Dr. Gerard A. Bourne, Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station; and Matthew Paschuk, Soil Conservation Service.

When the survey is completed, it will be possible to tell in advance of planting which of Connecticut's 150 types of soil is present in any particular area. This information will be published in separate reports for each county, together with a detailed color soil map of each county. General information on the soils of Connecticut is contained in Bulletin 423, "The Soil Characteristics of Connecticut," prepared by the Soil Conservation Service and available to residents of the State. The report contains a complete list of the 150 types of soil and a description of each.
