Talk Is Given Here on India

North End Pastor De-livers Address Before The Rotary Club

India's political and religious rebirth was explained to members of the Rotary club by Rev. William J. McLaughlin, pastor of the North Methodist church, at their meeting held at the Country Club last night. Rev. McLaughlin's talk was entitled "India's Rebirth." He was introduced to the Rotarians by Herb Swanson. To give his listeners a better understanding of his topic, the speaker explained the psychology that motivates the Indian mind. Birth and rebirth is the order of existence to the orthodox Hindu. One is reborn several times, they believe, and the status they enjoy on each successive rebirth is determined by the type of life they lived prior to their death. A man who has led a good life is reborn into a higher level of existence, while the "wicked" person may be reborn an animal or, still worse, an uncleanable.

In Political Field
Rev. McLaughlin discussed two of the several phases of India's rebirth. In the political field, he explained the workings of the new government and the more significant sections of the new constitution. Although the parliamentary system is similar to the British governmental set-up, the constitution provides for a Supreme court similar to that found in the United States.

One phase of the constitution that was highly praised by the speaker was that which, legally at least, eliminates untouchability, the "blot on Hindu society." The constitution also outlawed the caste and religious discrimination.

Although Mohandas K. Gandhi was a great spiritual leader, Rev. McLaughlin stressed the fact that the present Hindu leader, Prime Minister Nehru, is a well-trained and highly competent leader and was the "brains behind the Indian National Congress Party."

In discussing the division of India and Pakistan, the speaker said, "At no time in history have so many people won political freedom with so little shedding of blood." With the democratic principles with which India is now imbued, said the speaker, she is a great potential ally for the United States. "India is the only country in Asia that has her house in order," he said, and he expressed the hope that American dealings with India will be governed by an understanding of the peoples of India.

Rev. McLaughlin gave the Rotarians a view of the religious rebirth in India. Since the year 1000, the time of the first Muslim invasion, the people of India have been divided into two main camps, the Hindus and the Moslems, the latter being the largest minority group. Since the Moslem religion stresses one God and abhors idolatry, it is in conflict with the Hindu concept of God as a nebulous, impersonal Being, a rather shapeless and indefinite deity, according to Christian standards.

Christians As Peace-makers
The Moslem-Hindu conflict spread into politics and political parties soon lined up according to these religions. When the Moslems making their great migration into Pakistan met the Hindus going to India, "many heads were broken." The second largest minority group, the Christians, were called upon to serve the role of peace-makers, trying to bridge the gap of misunderstanding. The Christian element succeeded in helping to make a peaceful India.

A short question-answer period followed the close of the talk. Rev. McLaughlin spent two years at Lucknow, India, and was a member of the Rotary Club there. He did missionary work for 15 years and served as the head of the Department of Religion at Lucknow Christian College. At the present time, he is studying for his Ph.D. at the Hartford Seminary Foundation.

At the business meeting, the Rotarians voted a donation to the Camp for Handicapped Children. Plans were also discussed for the annual Rotary outing on August 13 at Arthur Benson's cottage in Coventry.







Malayan Reds Fight British

Open Battle Fought Today 80 Miles South of Siamese Border
Singapore, Aug. 4.—(AP)—Malayan Communist insurgents met British forces in open battle today, 80 miles south of the Siamese border.
A British Army communiqué said British forces, under cover of rocket-throwing Spitfires, are driving forward against stiff enemy opposition.
First reports did not indicate the scope of the battle. Presumably it was on a small scale. It is believed, however, to be the first time the Communists have stood and fought since the revolt began in the Malay Peninsula in 1946.
The communiqué said entrenched Communist opened fire with machine-guns and rifles upon a British column which was striking toward Pula, in a Communist stronghold.
British Column Resumes Advance
The column was held up by the fire and riddled for R. A. F. help. A later report said the British column—a joint military and police force—has resumed its advance.
At least one Gurkha soldier was reported killed.
Malcolm MacDonald, British high commissioner in southeast Asia, said last night the Communist timetable had called for proclamation of a Communist republic in Malaya yesterday. Instead, he said, the insurgents are "licking their wounds in the jungle."
British military offensives disrupted the timetable, MacDonald said. He said he felt Britain could hold the initiative and could restore peaceful conditions in a few months.

Arias Flees Into Exile

Former President of Panama Declares His Life Is in Danger
Balboa, C. Z., Aug. 4.—(AP)—Declaring "my life is in danger," Arnaldo Arias Madriz, former president of Panama, fled into political exile today for the second time.
Slight Edge Gives Opponent
His reference to "fraud" apparently was aimed at the outcome of the May presidential race. He claimed victory in the unofficial count but the official tally announced after months of counting gave a slight edge to his government-backed opponent, Domingo Diaz Arosemena.
Arias spent four years away from Panama, in exile, after being ousted from the presidency in 1941. His flight into the U. S.-controlled Canal Zone last night was his second in a month. He fled Panama on July 4 after a shooting affray involving members of his party and police. He went back July 19.
His departure today leaves Diaz with an undisputed claim of the presidency. The official count gave Diaz a margin of 1,116 votes over Arias.
The circumstances surrounding Arias' decision to leave are not known. It apparently was known to few, since there was no one at the airport to see him off for additional state offices. He later withdrew his resignation.

Hawleyville volunteer firemen doused the blazing truck before it could damage Gilbert's home.
