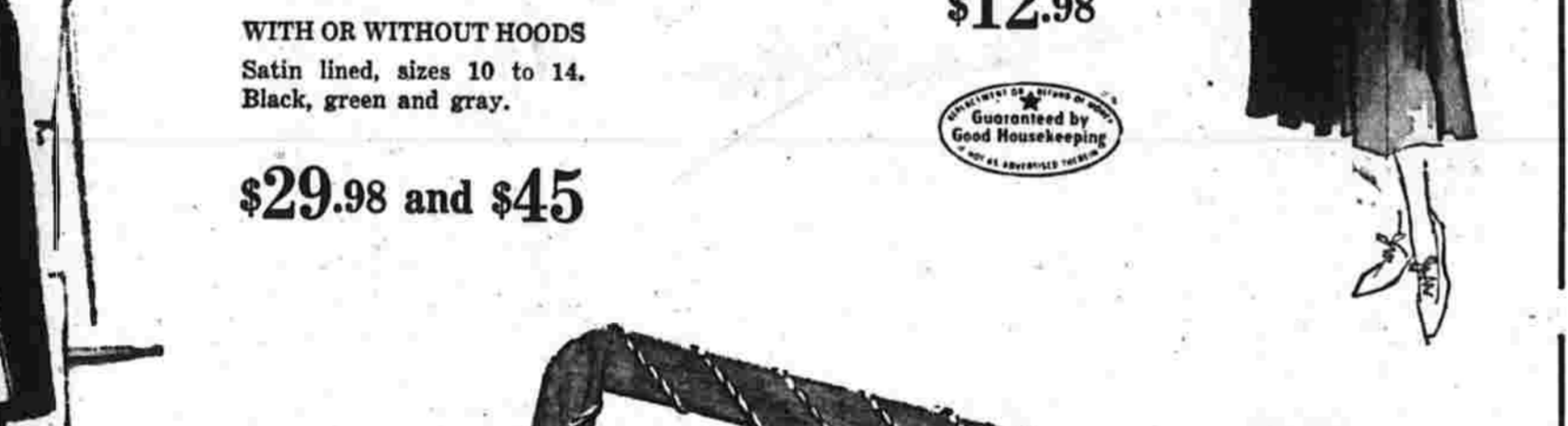

Sanity By Decree
 Ho, hum! Just when we were
 advising our readers to relax into
 a civilization in which every one
 would live on radio program give-
 ways, the Federal Communication
 Commission, a kill-joy, kill-
 free-entertainment, bureaucratic ty-
 rant with a threat to apply com-
 mands of legality to the radio
 bonanza programs.
 Beginning at some undeter-
 mined date, the FCC intends to
 regard the radio program as a
 business. If the winners are required
 to furnish any money or have in
 their possession any sponsor's
 product in order to be a winner,
 the winners are required to be
 listening to the program in order
 to win, or if the winners have
 to answer a question, and pre-
 vious editions of the program
 have given aids or hints toward
 the answering of that question,
 or if the winners are required to
 answer the telephone or write a
 letter, and that question or their
 writing being used on broad-
 cast.
 These regulations, if they are
 put into effect, seem likely to
 put most of the bonanza "pro-
 grams.
 It will, of course, be govern-
 ment dictatorialism of the most
 blatant kind. What the American
 public shall do is illustrated
 by just one statistic, that con-
 sidering the least weighted rating
 of radio's most authentic
 comedian, Fred Allen, Mr. Allen

 A Paris correspondent had a

 It is not necessary because
 final national policy. If negotia-
 tions are delicate, they can be
 conducted until they are healthy
 enough to stand the light of day,
 whereas popular debate on them,
 before all the gentle compromises
 involved had been achieved, might
 kill off all prospect of success.
 If the press, for instance, were
 now privileged to debate in de-

 secret diplomacy proceedings in
 Berlin and Moscow, there is
 little doubt that it could and
 would stir up some controversy
 over some of the bargains being
 discussed.
 But if the secret diplomats are
 not interrupted, they may pro-
 duce a whole pattern which is
 probably the best way to get
 things done. The French, who
 are probably the most expert
 in this line, are willing to accept

 doors.
 There is a great deal to be said
 for their point of view. But it
 would be erroneous to conclude
 that open diplomacy has passed
 fair trial and been proved want-

 There has been "open diplo-

 that constructive influence which
 it should rightly have. And there
 is no doubt that it has not
 proved healthy in the United
 Nations, that is perhaps
 because the nations themselves
 have not always adjusted them-
 selves to it, behaving as if their
 public diplomacy were a propa-
 ganda farce, with real issues
 to be settled behind closed doors.
 If the democrats would do
 not share the enthusiasm of the
 French for the return of secret
 diplomacy, it is, for the moment
 at least, a matter of regret that
