SHANNON IS GIVEN SALES TAX FIGURES. Hartford, Aug. 10.—Tax Commissioner Walter W. Walsh presented Governor Shuman today with first return figures under the new one per cent sales tax setup. The returns for the first six months of the fiscal year ending April-June—estimated at around \$2,000,000—will be made public Wednesday by the governor.
