Judiciary Committee Backs Shannon Plans

Tosses Democratic Proposals Into Discard; Meets Far Into Night After Hearings

Hartford, Aug. 25.—(AP)—The general assembly's judiciary committee, tossing Democratic proposals into the discard, recommended today adoption of Governor Shannon's program for meeting Connecticut's housing emergency.

Presented to the Legislature with a committee endorsement were measures which would:

1. Place an additional \$20,000,000 of the state's financial credit behind municipal housing projects.
2. Increase the retirement pay of local housing bonds from 35 to 50 years.
3. Declare a virtual moratorium on evictions, except for non-payment of rent or commission of a nuisance, by providing a cheap and easy means whereby tenants can appeal from eviction actions to the Common Pleas court and obtain delays up to seven months.

Endorses Old Age Proposal

In addition, the committee endorsed the government's proposal that old age pensions be boosted from \$45 to \$50 a month, and rejected a Democratic bill calling for a maximum monthly payment of \$60.

Also approved was a measure authorizing Groton to issue \$250,000 in bonds to finance construction of new water works needed to provide water service to housing projects.

The committee met far into the night to act on the measures after spending hours yesterday listening to suggestions for meeting the housing problem.

In endorsing the government's program, it went back to the direct subsidy program, advocated chiefly by Chester Bowles, Democratic candidate for governor, who was backed by various veteran labor and political groups.

Fredrickson Debate

Leaders of both parties predicted that the committee's action would touch off an intense partisan debate in the Legislature—an argument which they said probably would continue as one of the main issues of the approaching political campaign.

Approval of the government's program was being taken for granted on both sides of the political fence, however, since Republicans are in firm control of both House and Senate.

The Legislature, which opened a special emergency session Monday, was expected to adjourn as soon

"The Democratic nominee can afford to make generous promises and repeal all taxes—his chances of having the opportunity look not too bright at this time."

Challenged directly to say how he proposed to finance his housing program, Bowles said he had no suggestions at the present time. But it was essential, he contended, to get the program started at once and leave the financing to the next regular session of the General Assembly next January.

The Democratic housing plan was backed by labor and veterans groups at the hearing.

Republican leaders asserted that the 1948 General Assembly undoubtedly would consider a program of state housing subsidies after it convenes next January. But they contended, it would be unwise for such a sweeping and costly program to be undertaken at a brief, emergency special session.
