Dewey Says Land And Water to Be Assets for West

Pledges Development in Answer to Truman's Charge Republicans Plan 'Sabotage' of Region; Denver Speech Scheduled for Tonight

En Route to Denver With Dewey Sept. 21—(AP)—Western water and land development was pledged today by Gov. Thomas E. Dewey in answer to President Truman's charge that the Republicans plan "sabotage of the west."

Truman told western Colorado voters today it seemed to him that everybody had enough that he called the 80th do-nothing Congress.

He spoke to a station audience from a rear platform of a special train when it pulled into Wood Springs early this morning.

Several hundred persons were on hand to greet the governor as he headed toward Utah and another major address on reclamation and water problems and the future. He will pledge an administration that understands our land and water problems and that will keep our country strong as it works earnestly for peace in the world.

Direct Reply to Truman This added up to a direct reply to Mr. Truman's assertion that the Republicans win in November they will "try to turn back the clock to the day when there was an economic colony of Wall Street."

Republicans were visibly disappointed that rain spoiled the plans for an open air meeting at Des Moines last night when the Republican nominee called in his first formal speech of the campaign for "a foreign policy based on the belief that we can have peace without a big, expensive arms race."

After his speech, the governor drove in an open car around the Denver stadium where an overflow of several thousand people listened to his talk over a public address system.

Dewey's move into Colorado emphasized his support of William F. Buckley, G. O. P. nominee for the Senate, who is opposing Senator Edwin C. Johnson, Democrat. Sets Forth New Doctrine While Mr. Truman blamed the Republicans in his Denver address for high prices, Dewey claimed himself in Des Moines with setting the record.

Lambastes "Bellwether Threat" Talking at Tulsa, Okla., the California lambasted Truman for "temperate threats," and charged they proved only the inept administration had become a "shambles."

Warren took Mr. Truman to task for his campaign-opening remark, "I am going to give them hell."

"Such a threat can prove only one thing," he said. "That is, that the incumbent administration is a shambles; that it is dispirited, chaotic, quarrelsome and desperate."
