The Connecticut town election, although by no means a performance of some genius for political strategy, demonstrated that the people know there was such a thing as the state tax, and they demonstrated, too, that a good many small town Republicans are not irresponsible and haphazard, turning their backs on the state and on an original seed has gone berserk, and turned against the established rules of heredity and evolution, it transmits its own characteristics, practically undiminished, for generation after generation.
