New Haven, Oct. 25.—Police chasing an automobile at high speed through several downtown streets today found two men in the vehicle after two men abandoned it and ran away.

The money collected will be used to construct an orphanage in Cassino which will help to shelter homeless children and provide clothing, food, medicine and care for them.

The orphanage will be a living memorial to American war dead helping to save the lives of thousands of children who are homeless, orphaned, uncared for, hungry and unclothed, each aside in the wake of the Italian army.



Lehar Seen Kindly Man

East Hartford Police Sergeant Recalls Deceased Compozer

East Hartford, Oct. 25.—(AP)—Franz Lehar was a kindly old gentleman who, in a surrounding of gifts and mementos from all the crowned heads of Europe, got his greatest kick from playing "The Merry Widow Waltz" before young GIs who had never heard of him.

"That's the way Sgt. John W. Gompfer of East Hartford police remembers the famed Austrian composer who died Saturday.

Sergeant Gompfer, then a lieutenant in the U.S. Army, was stationed in Lima, Austria, in 1945 as a public safety officer.

"He was an unhappy man who never expected to see Vienna again and who had despaired of receiving thousands of dollars in American royalties that was coming to him. But even at 75 his spirit was still there.

Sergeant Gompfer recalls the beautiful villa amidst the towering Alps next to which Emperor Joseph had built his summer home.

"His walls were lined with pictures and gifts from all Europe's royalty," the sergeant remembers.

"When I became known that Lehar was there, hundreds of soldiers tried to visit him. They couldn't have too many visitors, but occasionally he would play his American royalties that was coming to him."

Once a GI jazz band came to play for him and he followed their performance with a few pieces of his own. "Gee," one soldier remarked, "that old guy plays pretty good. Who is he?"

Everyone who came to see the composer—his home became a sort of "mecca"—was invited to see. One time, Sergeant Gompfer relates, a visitor "adopted" a fan on each blade of which was an autograph of one of Europe's most famous names.

Military intelligence finally located the fan back in the United States and it was voluntarily returned to Lehar—insured for \$15,000.
