Three Balkan Nations

Condemned for Giving Aid to Reds in Greece

Paris, Nov. 5.—(AP)—The United Nations Political Committee voted today to condemn Albania, Bulgaria and Yugoslavia for helping the Communist rebels in Greece.

Two More Innocent Victims

By a vote of 47 to 0, the committee approved a paragraph in a four-point resolution demanding that continued aid given by the three Balkan nations to the Greek guerrillas endanger peace in the Balkans and is inconsistent with the principles of the United Nations charter.

The vote followed hours of wrangling during which the Bulgarians fought to stall the proceedings and three repeated tongue-lashing from the committee chairman, Paul-Henri Spaak of Belgium.

Overnight the Greek government had responded to a plan from the president of the Assembly by postponing execution of 10 sentences, scheduled to be today.

The six Balkan nations refused to vote on the condemnation paragraph. They served notice they would vote against the whole resolution when it comes up, perhaps later today. The vote does not apply.

Four nations were absent when the vote was taken.

Withdrawal Plan Not Backed by Americans
