



He explained the different steps, beginning with washing the lanolin oil and dirt from the newly-shorn sheep wool, and then coloring it with vegetable dye. The dyes are obtained by boiling such things as sumac, alum, black walnut, onion skins, apple bark and lichen. Carding, or combing out the snarls, to draw the fibers into parallel position in preparation for weaving on the spinning wheel came next, and finally the actual spinning of the yarn.

Many samples of homespun yarn and woven tapestries, rugs, runners, and bed spreads were displayed.
