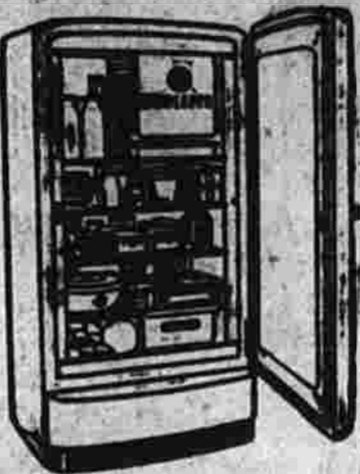

The announcement stated that 22 extra trains will be operated Wednesday, on Thursday and 26 on Sunday when the home-bound traffic is expected to reach its peak.

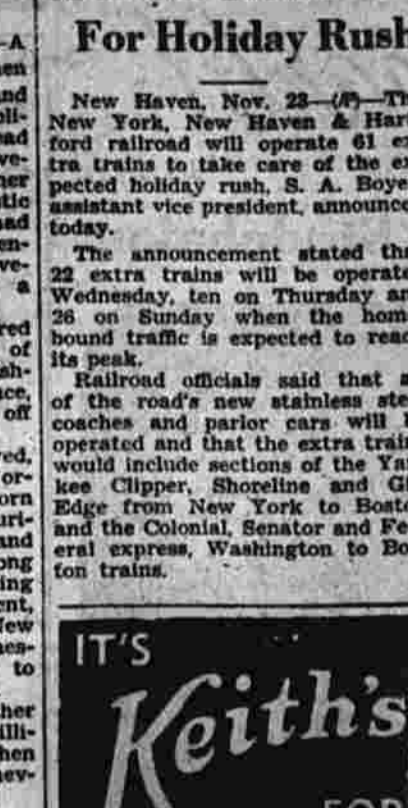

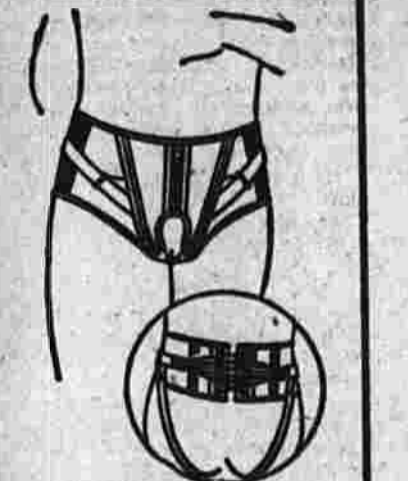
