To Introduce New DP Bill Will Eliminate All Features Causing Objection to Present Law

Washington, Dec. 8.—Representative Walter D. Pae, Jr., today introduced a bill which would eliminate all the features President Truman has objected to in the present law.

Walter, the No. 2 Democrat on the House Judiciary committee which handles such legislation, told a reporter he will introduce the measure when the new Congress opens January 3.

The bill, he said, would guarantee against racial, religious or political discrimination, double the number of European refugees eligible to enter the United States, and give them four years—instead of two years—from July to apply for admission.

Denounced As Infringement of the present law, 205,000 European refugees are to be given entry to this country the next two years. The measure passed by the 80th Congress last July, was denounced by President Truman during the recent campaign as being unfair to Jews and Catholics.
