Nationalist Units Begin Evacuating Pengpu Positions

Withdrawing to Chuh-shien, Only 30 Miles North of Nanking; Action Coincides With Reliable Reports of Wiping Out of 12th Army

Nanking, Dec. 17.—(P)—Supreme headquarters of Chiang Kai-shek's east China command today began withdrawing from threatened Pengpu to Chuh-shien, only 30 miles north of this uneasy capital. Pengpu, 105 miles northwest of Nanking, is the anchor for the government's new line of defense. It became a Nationalist headquarters after the abandonment of the stronghold of Fuchow, 125 miles farther north.

The withdrawal coincided with reliable reports that the government's 12th Army, garrisoned at Pengpu, had been wiped out. Official dispatches Thursday reported that the 12th was making a last stand with less than half its original force of 110,000 troops. They were described as compressed into an area of only three miles in circumference.

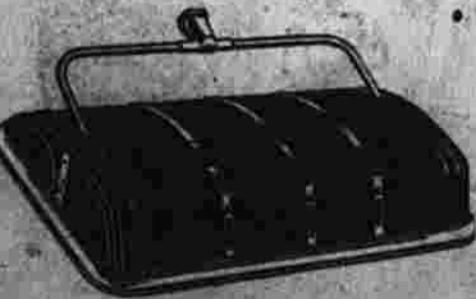

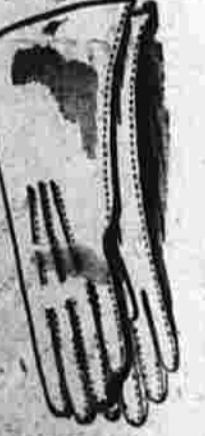

Swivel Wheels, Stall Horn. New Boons to Mass Flying

By NEA Service. Washington (NEA) — Two valuable aids to mass flying which the Civil Aeronautics Administration has developed after long experimentation are now being produced on the aviation market, the CAA has announced. One is the castor-type landing gear, which makes landings possible even when runways do not face directly into the wind. The second is an automatic stall-warning device which tells a pilot when his plane is in danger of a spin. The castor-type landing gear, which swivels like the wheels on an office chair, was perfected some time ago for small planes, and now has proved equally practical on aircraft as large as the DC-3. It permits a plane to turn its nose into a cross-wind and still roll along the ground in the direction of the runway. CAA, which received a \$150,000 appropriation to perfect the idea, hopes that in addition to providing safe, almost foolproof landings without danger of groundloop, the castor-type landing gear may eventually cut the cost of large airports as much as 50 per cent by cutting down the number of runways now necessary. Replacement wheels that swivel are now being manufactured for seven types of aircraft, although no planes are as yet being manufactured with the new-type gear as original equipment. The stall warning is a vane on the leading edge of the wing, which sets off a horn and a red light on the instrument panel to warn the pilot his plane is approaching a stall. A plane stalls when its angle of climb becomes too great for its speed. Immense crashes have resulted from spins caused by stalls. Birthmark Superstitions Have No Scientific Basis Whatever

Malformations of the skin, called birthmarks, are usually so small, covered with hair, or placed in such an inconspicuous part of the body that they do not cause any concern. Occasionally, large ones appear on the face or some other conspicuous part of the body where they seriously mar the looks.

The superstition that birthmarks come because of an unfortunate incident occurring to the mother during pregnancy is entirely false. For example, birthmarks are sometimes attributed to a fright of the mother. All such ideas have no scientific basis whatever.

Birthmark Types

Many birthmarks are made up of numerous tiny blood vessels in the skin. Some are level with the surface of the skin but have a dark purplish color which gives them the common name of port wine mark. Some birthmarks made up of blood vessels are raised above the skin level and are soft and spongy. These are called strawberry marks. This type may occur anywhere, but is particularly common around the lips or tongue. Another common variety of birthmark made up of blood vessels is irregularly shaped and slightly raised. It is called a spider nevus because of the resemblance to a spider.

The proper treatment for a birthmark depends on the location, the size, and the particular variety of the defect. Many moles can be removed by local treatment, including surgery, various types of electric cautery, freezing with carbon dioxide snow, X-rays or radium and certain chemical agents.

There are various ways of treating port wine nevus or birthmarks, all aimed at closing off the blood vessels, so that blood ceases to flow through. Carbon dioxide snow may be used for the small ones. These birthmarks require delicate handling, however, as there is some danger of leaving an abnormal skin after the port wine birthmark has been destroyed. Radium treatment is also effective in some cases. There is also a new type of treatment with what is called the Grenz ray. The same kinds of treatment can be considered for the strawberry mark, or the spider nevus.

When treatment does not yield good results, the affected area often can be covered with some preparation which looks like the normal skin.

Kentucky Garage Man Fights a Dam That Threatens Rich Ice Age Relics

Blue Li-La, Ky. (NEA) — Scientists can thank a garage man if they get a chance to study a rich record of Ice Age life before it is forever blotted out by the rising waters of another dam.

The garage operator, Victor K. Dodge, of Lexington, Ky., is trying to delay construction of a flood control dam across the Licking river at Palomoth, above which lies the only "dying place" of gigantic mammals on the American continent known to those who study prehistoric life.

At Blue Licks spring and in the salt bog at Big Bone Lick, mastodons in ages past were trapped in the spongy mire and starved to death.

The now-dried trapper marishes have yielded rare fossils of mastodons, mammoths and a muskox now in the Peabody museum at Yale University.

Geologists feel sure that the bog contains skeletal remains of vast numbers of mastodons as well as the fossils of other extinct Ice Age animals.

Dodge, a naturalist and paleontologist in his spare time, has been organizing excavating parties at his own expense while urging study by experts of the Blue Licks state park museum and the skull of a mastodons found in the Peabody museum at Yale University.

While Dodge has been rallying educators, scientists and legislators in behalf of recovery of the bone relics still entombed, farm owners of this area have organized in opposition to creation of the artificial lake for another reason. They claim its waters will remove from cultivation some of the best farming land in Kentucky. But engineers insist it will prevent floods on the lower Ohio and Mississippi rivers.

Property owners of the fossil bed declare they will not sell it to the government for reservoir use without court action. But it is available almost for the asking should the Commonwealth of Kentucky "for the education and scientific advancement of the people" take the lead in the excavation work.

Yankee Flight from Shanghai
Army Wives and Civilians Pull Out as Reds Gain

Shanghai (NEA) — Perhaps it's old stuff to Army wives and their kiddies, but it always brings tears.

Once again they are being pulled away from their soldier husbands. A few years ago it was a world war. Before or since it has been a change of station. Today it is China's civil war.

The 900-odd dependents of officers and men of the Joint United States Military Advisory Group are pulling out of China in the face of the Chinese Communist advance. One group of them left on the U. S. Army transport Republic.

With them, by Army arrangement, went civilians who are fleeing China, too: men who have spent a lifetime in business here, Chinese-Americans, exchange students, professors.

"I'll be home soon," a captain could be heard saying to his attractive wife. "Don't worry, honey. They'll get us out of this mess in time."

"Take care of yourself, Harry," shouted another wife, waving from a deck to a young man in a camel's hair coat on the dock.

"And a youngster who might have been four or five looked up: "Shoot those dirty old Reds for me, daddy!"

There were tears in some eyes for another reason: Shanghai has been home to many of these people for years of residence here. Much as they may hate its crowds, noise and dirt, these Old China Hands revel in its easy life, intrigue and excitement.

Perhaps the most senior passenger was the Rev. James M. Wilson, of Louisville, Ky. For 36 years an Episcopal missionary in China, Wilson has made a similar trip before. After months in a Japanese concentration camp, he was repatriated on the Swedish ship Gripsholm in 1943.

"Of course I'm glad to be going now," the missionary said. "Anybody would under conditions in China now." But he wished that things were different in China, that it was a country fit to remain in.

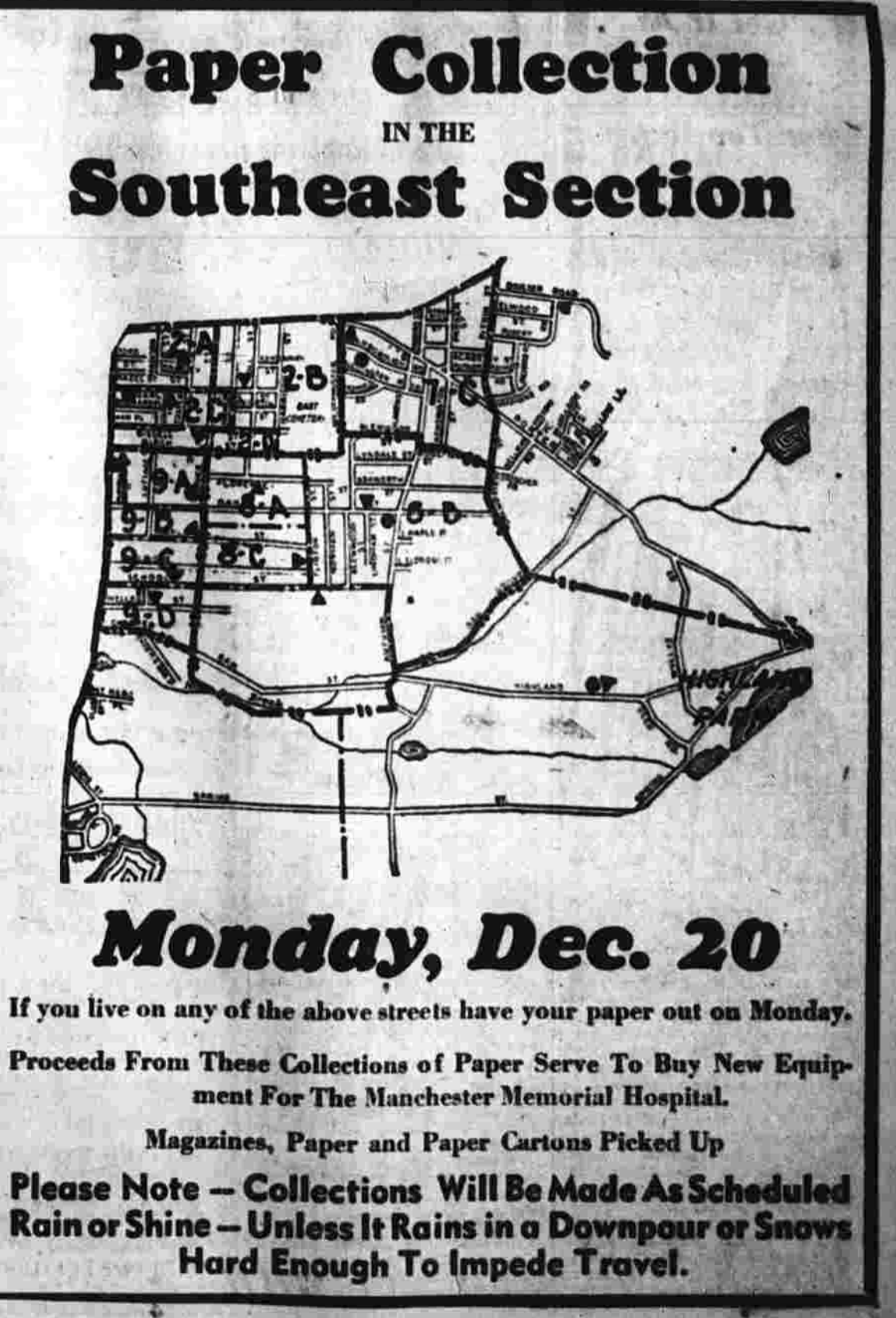
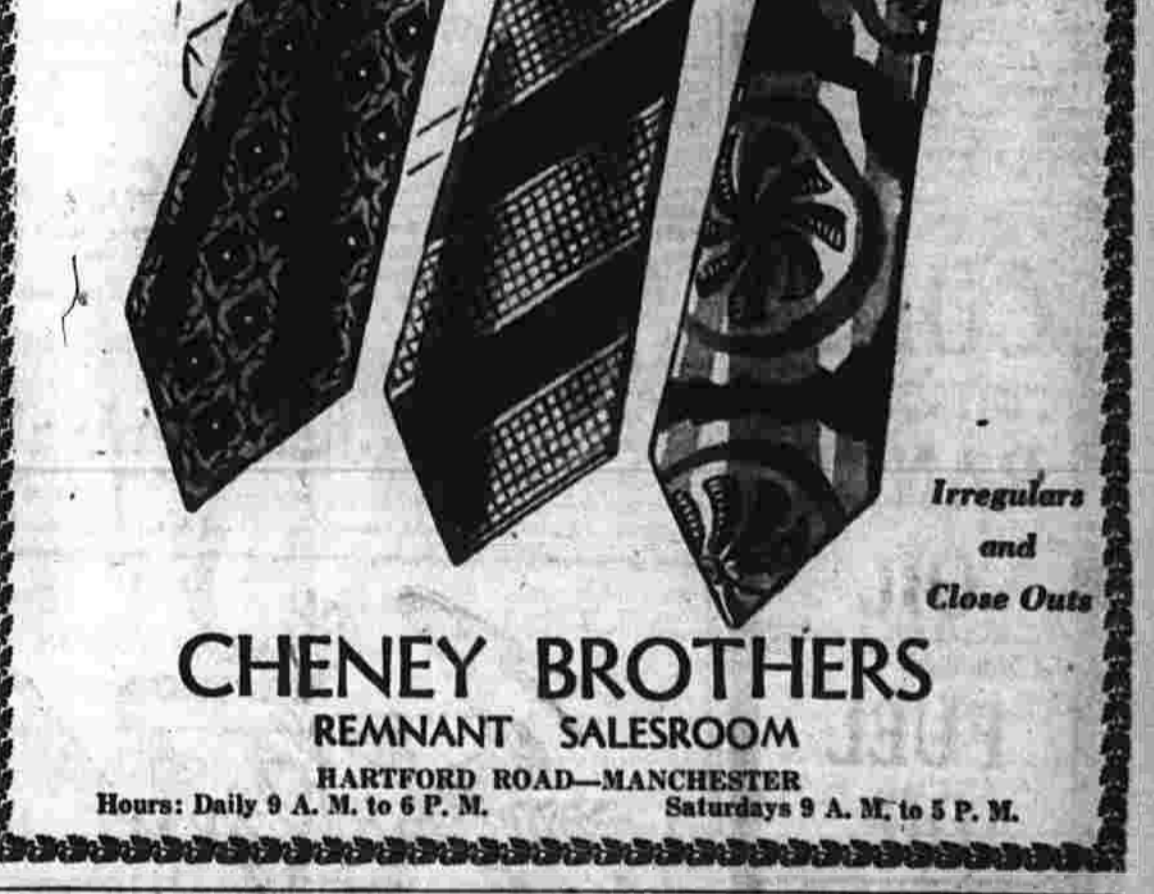
