ity for west Berliners during the Christmas holidays.
Meaning the Communist appointed lord mayor of eastern Berlin, Friedrich Ebert, whom rumors last night had on his way to western Germany, addressed a rally of about 2,000 city employees in the Soviet sector of the town.
Since the Russians set up a puppet government in eastern Berlin and refused to cooperate in the four-power government, it has been expected the west would set up its own military government structure.
The German administration elected Dec. 5 in the west urged the west to set up a government and do away with sector borders between Berlin and the rest of the Berlin municipal government.

Taft to Head Policy Group

Almost Sure Bet to Resume His Familiar Role in New Senate

Washington, Dec. 21.—(AP)—Despite threats of party revolt, Senator Taft of Ohio appeared in the House today to resume his familiar role as chief Republican policy maker in the new Senate.

The Ohioan was said to have received such assurances of support as to make his re-election as chairman of the C. O. P. Policy committee an almost foregone conclusion.

This would mean, colleagues said, that so far as the Senate is concerned, Taft again will find opposing many of his proposals the same man who clashed bitterly with him in the past over such issues as price controls and labor legislation.

Compromise Seen Likely
Taft's grip on the policy-making post seemed unlikely to be retained, however, without some kind of compromise with self-styled liberals who have been demanding a greater voice in charting the party's course.

Senior Ives of New York, long-time supporter of Gov. Thomas E. Dewey, predicted at a news conference yesterday that a dozen senators from the northwest, the Pacific coast and a few from the interior will make their weight felt in party caucus.

He said they represent a forward-looking viewpoint, and implied that those who have been running the Republican Senate since the inception of the party are "a little more conservative."

However, Ives himself admitted that if the insurgents can muster only 12 or so of the 42 Republican votes in the new Senate they haven't much chance of upsetting the leadership apparatus.

Best bet at the moment was that the veterans in the driver's seat will enlarge the Policy committee.

To Raise Pay At Travelers

Thousands of Employees Informed of Increases As of First of Year

Hartford, Dec. 21.—(AP)—Thousands of employees of the Travelers companies in these offices throughout the United States and Canada, including the home office in Hartford, have been informed of increases in pay effective as of the first of the coming year.

All increases are based on individual merit and go proportionately to those whose work, experience and responsibility have increased during the year.

The companies also are initiating a plan of award for length of service. At its inception this plan means that nearly 5,000 employees are to receive substantial awards for 25 years of service, and a smaller number additional awards for 40 years of service.

For many years the companies have paid for group life insurance in limited amounts on the employ-

ees and have also made available to them a contributory basis hospital and surgical benefits. Hospital benefits for dependents have also been available at a minimum cost to employees for several years.

It has now been decided to give the employees the opportunity to secure additional group life insurance and group surgical benefits for their dependents at a low cost. A portion of the cost of these extensions, or group insurance benefits, will be paid for by the companies.

Court Studies Voting Rights

Negroes in Alabama Are Treated Differently Than White Persons

Mobile, Ala., Dec. 21.—(AP)—A three-judge Federal court today studied testimony by a member of the Mobile County Board of Registrars who said Negroes applying for registration to vote were treated differently than white persons.

The witness, E. J. Gonzalez, testified yesterday at a court trial on the constitutionality of Alabama's voter-qualification law, the Bow-well amendment.

Gonzalez said most Negroes were given tests on the U. S. constitution, but that he had not been present when any white applicants were tested.

Tested Rights Frustrated
Ten Mobile county Negroes contend the amendment infringes on their constitutional rights by granting wide discretion to the registrars.

The two-year-old amendment provides that applicants for registration as voters must be able to understand and explain the Federal constitution to the Board of Registrars' satisfaction.

At the outset of the trial, attorneys for the registrars asked the court to eliminate Gonzalez, one of the three board members, as a defendant.

Assistant State Attorney General Elias C. Garrett, III, said he had discovered that Gonzalez would not go along with the other board members in their defense of the law.

Gonzalez said "I cannot agree with the other board members. I asked me to testify to it in this case."

The trial was continued today.
