New Probate Court Judge

John J. Wallitt to Assume His Office a Week from Today

John J. Wallitt, who was elected judge of probate in November, will assume his new office on January 5, one week from today. His term of office will be for two years. Mr. Wallitt succeeds the late Judge William E. Hyde who held the office for 28 years and had already been nominated by the Republican caucus for another two-year term. When Judge Hyde became ill, Hartford was appointed acting judge and has since presided at all sessions of the court. The Friday session of the court will bring his appointment as acting judge to an end.

Judge Hyde was first elected to the office in 1917 to fill the unexpired term of Judge Oliver R. Wood and was elected each term thereafter until his death this year. Had Judge Hyde lived to the end of the term being started by Mr. Wallitt, the former would have retired since he would have reached his 70th birthday.

On the death of Judge Hyde, the Republican Town committee unanimously selected Wallitt as the Republican candidate, and although the Democrats had already nominated Wesley Gray, Mr. Wallitt won out in the election, running well ahead of his ticket.

35 Years' Service

Mr. Wallitt served in the probate court under Judge Hyde for 23 years. On the same day Wallitt assumes his office, the senior justices of the peace, four Republicans and three Democrats, will also take office. This will be the first time that Manchester will have seven justices of the peace. Previously, the town has had 13.

When Manchester adopted its new charter, the number of justices was cut from 13 to seven, but this is the first year that the voters of Manchester have been asked to select only seven justices.

New Haven, Dec. 28—(AP)—The economy axe is swinging in the "New Haven" railroad system. And it won't stop swinging, says President Laurence F. Whittemore, until there has been a "substantial reduction" in the payroll.

The railroad's new president outlined aims of the present management last night at a dinner of the road's directors, Mayor William C. Celestano of New Haven, and a group of the city's businessmen.

"It has been, and is," he said, "the task of the present management to put its business house in order by substantial reduction in the number of people employed by the New Haven as well as the number of activities strictly railroad business in which the company has engaged."

"We must not stop until every man on our railroad has a full-time necessary day's work on his hands. We shall endeavor to bring this with as little personal hardship to individuals and communities as possible."

Democratic Sweep Tops State News

Lot of Other Important Happenings in 1948: Outstanding News Is Reviewed

By Paul V. Cochran New Haven, Dec. 29—(AP)—If you were to ask what was Connecticut's most important story in 1948, the answer probably would be the Democratic sweep that sent Chester Bowles, one-time national OPA chairman to the governor's mansion, elected all but one of his colleagues on the state ticket and made important inroads into the formerly solid Republican congressional delegation.

House Situation Unsettled The housing situation remained unsettled, despite a reported \$300,000,000 in state guaranteed bonds which a special session of the legislature authorized on top of a previous grant of \$15,000,000. In spite of the enlarged grant and despite many housing enterprises that have been started, the state's housing shortage remains acute.

Another special session of the Legislature did something about cutting the state sales tax from three to one per cent. Eventually the tax will be abolished and replaced by a 10 per cent. unless the Legislature decides otherwise.

Highway Building Progress Despite increased costs in many fields, the state made notable progress with its highway building. It opened the \$60,000,000 bridge over the mouth of the Connecticut and in doing so sped up traffic on the nation's premier artery—U. S. 1.

It completed a long stretch of Cross Highway to the Massachusetts line and it finally held through the last important link in that multi-million dollar superhighway—the West Rock turnpike in New Haven.
