Surgical management. Even when it seems to be entirely checked and the discharge is gone, a new cold may bring back the condition all over again. Q's and A's

Q-Is it possible to make a screen which one can see through in one direction and not in the other?
A-No, not if the illumination is equal on both sides. However, a very finely silvered mirror can be used as a one-way screen for light if one side is illuminated much more brilliantly than the other.

Q-What is the approximate population of Hawaii?
