

Likely to Play Second Fiddle

Indirect Notice of Attitude Toward Navy Is Seen in Reaction... Washington, Feb. 4.—The Navy got the worst mark today that it probably is going to have to play second fiddle to the Air Force in Congress.

Indirect notice of this attitude came in the form of "what-ifs" scattered among lawmakers to an announcement by Secretary Sully that the Navy will have to play up 75 ships and cut its strength 50,000 men to keep within President Truman's new budget.

It was in direct contrast to the strong sentiment that has grown up in Congress to push Air Force developments far beyond the 48-group set-up proposed by Mr. Truman.

Not A Real Choice

On the surface, Governor Chas. Bowles' budget message proposed a state controversy between two opposing forms of tax—the sales tax, which we have now, and the income tax, which he would prefer to substitute for the sales tax.

Actually, it is not, at least as Governor Bowles presents it, a valid controversy. It is not a controversy between that kind of income tax which is perfect in theory and the sales tax, it is a controversy between an income tax which has been divorced from basic income tax theory and a sales tax.

This is so because, as Governor Bowles proposes an income tax, it would not be a measure taking from most Connecticut citizens in accordance with their ability to pay. It would, as a matter of fact, take from relatively few Connecticut citizens—only those making \$4,000 a year or more.

There are two reasons why the great majority of Connecticut citizens will be excused from any part of the tax of paying for the state bonus and the additional aid to education which are the particular state functions which made this additional revenue necessary.

This kind of tax is not really an income tax. It is a tax to collect a certain portion of the state's revenues from a certain small percentage of the state's population, and to excuse all the rest of the state population. It is based only on a very special interpretation of the principle of "ability to pay."

There is no reason for anyone who really believes in the principle of the income tax to support the Bowles proposal. The income tax, when it is manufactured away from its own basic principles, can become quite discriminatory and unfair in any other kind of tax.

It can be aimed just as other taxes can be aimed, and the Bowles proposal has the same effect. The sales tax, on the other hand, is in its basic form, a tax which is much less pleasant in principle than a pure income tax.

Undoubtedly, it places a heavier percentage burden upon the poor and the middle classes than it strictly just. Undoubtedly, it is a tax under which the rich escape any excessive burden of taxation.

But the sales tax, also, can be diverted from its own basic principles. Exemptions and limits can do much to shift it away from bearing with exclusive heaviness upon the poor. And the present Connecticut sales tax does this.

The choice is not between the income tax principle and the sales tax principle, but between a basic distortion of the income tax and a moderate form of sales tax. What we have now is the lesser of the two evils.

There is no evidence that the churchman was not speaking of his own will and his own mind. What, then, was his purpose?

For Communist purposes, they do not consider religion necessary to tread as easily as they are treading in Poland. And rather than permit Cardinal Mindszenty to play a role in calling off the dogs, they are determined to use him as their excuse for promoting more strife.

Then, presumably, they get on their feet and go out into the world. They have resigned from it. They no longer hold any slight share of responsibility for it. Let it go to the devil, outside the shutters.

What do we think of that? Well, few people who have ever thought about the world in which they live can fail to have some understanding of the motives involved. Who has not, at some time or other, felt like abandoning citizenship and responsibility and participation and retiring behind some cloister? But to yield to this instinct, actually to live by it, seems to us to be a betrayal of life itself. If there was any slight way in which either of these two people could have made the outside world just a shade better, in the music that will pollinate violin could, just once in a lifetime, have played strength and grace to an audience of just one additional person—then an opportunity was tragically missed. Then the gift that these lives had been entrusted to give was broken and shattered by an act of perverse will, or timid resignation.

Not all those who resign from the world go into some remote house and close the shutters. But, although they walk on Main street, they are sometimes as blind as though they had been encased themselves physically. Never choose to be ignorant of what you have to give to the world, or of what the world has to give to you.

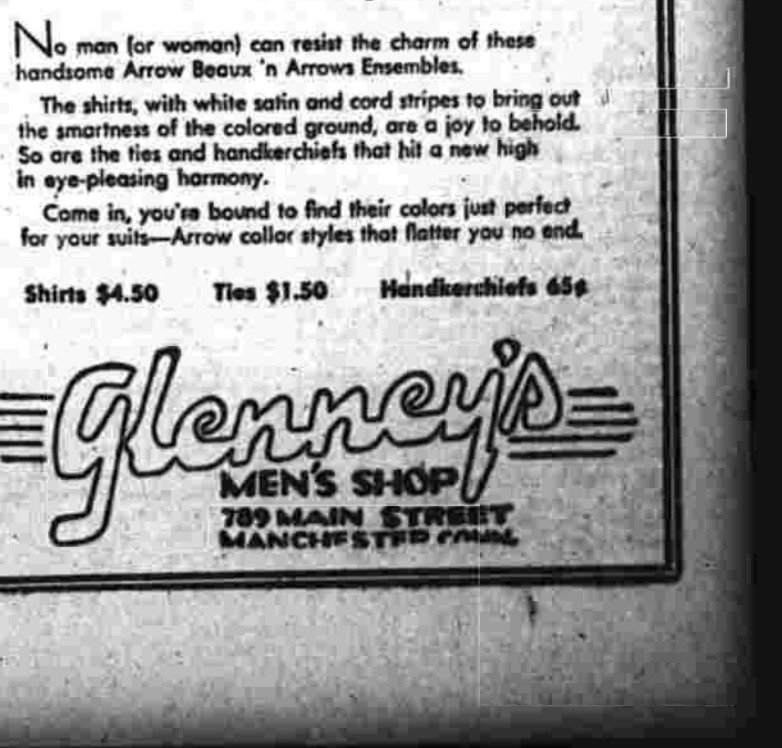

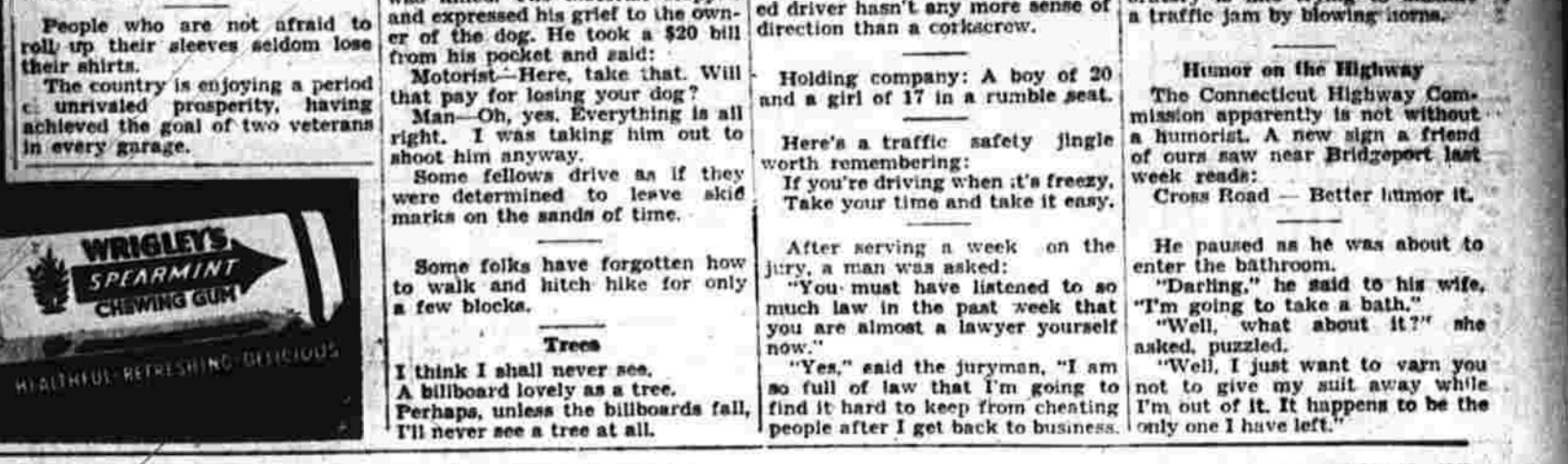
