Salaries of Town Clerks In State Municipalities

Of Connecticut's 169 towns there are 22, including Manchester, which retain their town clerks on a straight fee payment basis, while in 20 additional towns, clerks receive both salaries and certain fees according to information compiled for release by the Connecticut Public Expenditure Council. In 20 towns collectors get paid by a set percentage of what they collect, the range being from one to two per cent. Some collectors get a small salary plus certain fees. Manchester pays seventh highest salary to a clerk, it being noted at \$7,200, with an additional \$2,800 for a city clerk. Hartford pays its town clerk \$4,000, and the larger towns, East Hartford, Naugatuck, Danbury, Wallingford and West Hartford, also like this town, pay their town clerks on a fee basis.

Corrigan for the death on Dec. 24 of John B. Shortell, 62, of 28 Wooster street. Shortell died after being struck on the head with a block of wood.

Norwich, March 24 (AP)—Funeral services for the Rev. Ray M. Wilson, rector of Trinity Episcopal church here, will be held Friday afternoon in the church. Mr. Wilson died yesterday after a long illness. He came to the church in October, 1948, but was unable to conduct only one service before illness incapacitated him. He came to Norwich from Calvary church in Bridgeport where he served 16 years. Survivors include his widow, the former Julia McGrath, two daughters and a son. Burial will be in Bridgeport.

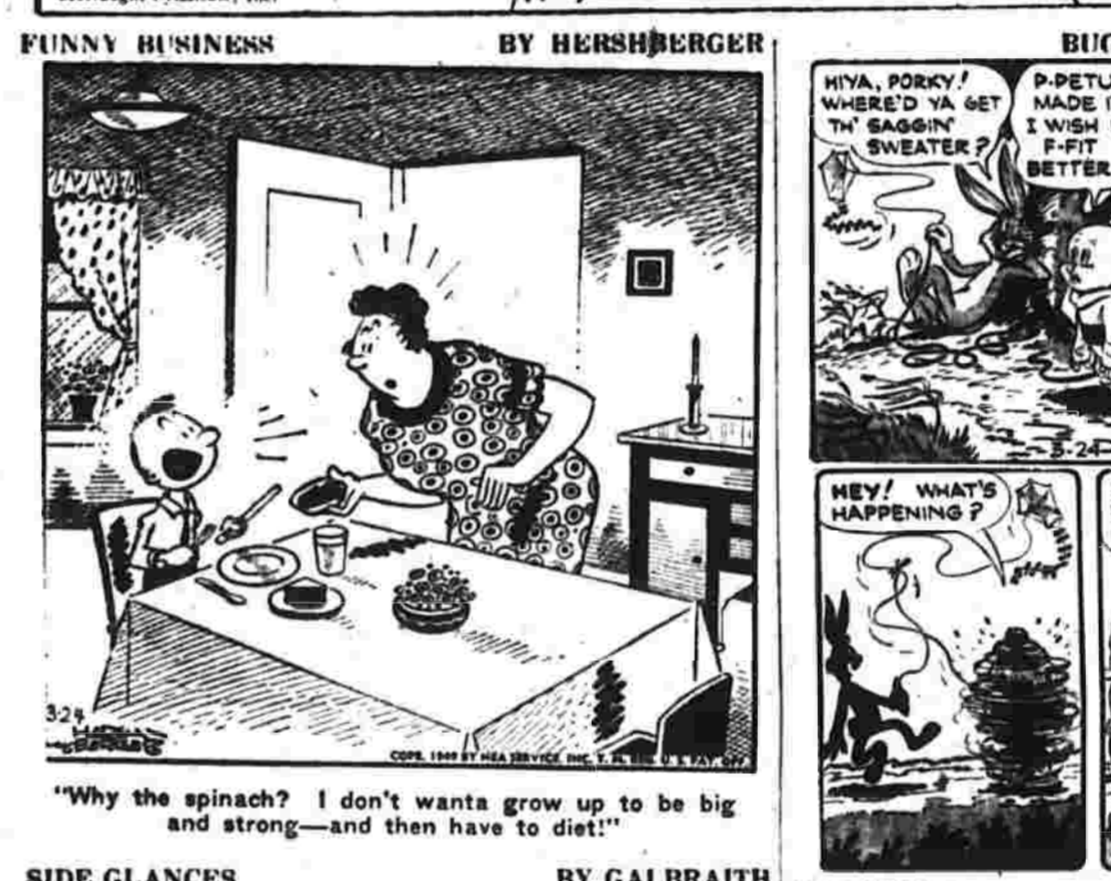
