Russian Stand Hit by Aitlee

Britain's Prime Minister Asserts 'Rulers of Kremlin' Divide World

Glasgow, Scotland, April 11.—(AP)—Prime Minister Clement Aitlee declared yesterday in a bitter attack on Russia that the "rulers of the Kremlin" had divided the world.

The chief of Britain's Labor government spoke at a party rally in this city, where he said that the "rulers of the Kremlin" had divided the world into two camps: the "free world" and the "Communist world."

Aitlee declared the vast majority of Britons favored the Atlantic pact, which he said is "purely defensive."

Those who are against the pact, he said, "are the Communist and their fellow travelers, and a few fanatics who are hostile to the United States but who are not."
