Union Locals Found Unfair

Section of Taft-Hartley Act Violated

Bridgeport, April 16.—Two Bridgeport locals of the AFL Teamsters union have been found guilty of unfair labor practices charges arising from the picketing of three stores here.

A NLRB trial examiner, in a report made public in Washington yesterday, held that the unions had violated a section of the Taft-Hartley act prohibiting "recognition" boycotts and sympathy strikes.

The case was the first decided under that section.

No dispute with stores. The unions had no dispute with the three stores which were picketing. One of them was attempting to win recognition from the Bridgeport United Delivery Service, Inc., which rents trucks to the stores.

The unions involved are Local 145, Service Trade Chauffeurs, Salesmen and Helpers, a Teamsters affiliate, and Local 121 of the Teamsters. Charges against Local 145 were filed by two department stores, the "Bishop Dry Goods company and D. M. Reed company, which rents trucks to the stores. The charges against Local 121 were filed by the Bishop Dry Goods company. The case had its background in a strike called by Local 121 against the delivery service's drivers, which was won by the union.

Local 121 picked three stores established at the three stores by Local 145, and Local 121 instructed its members not to cross them.

The trial examiner, Walter F. Schumaker, found that the unions had violated Section 8 (B), (4) of the Taft-Hartley Act. That section makes it an unfair labor practice for a union to engage in a strike or boycott, or to "induce or encourage" the employees of any employer to engage in a strike or boycott, where an object thereof is to force or require another employer to recognize or bargain with a labor organization as the representative of its employees unless the labor organization has been certified as the representative of such employees by the National Labor Relations Board.
