Manchester Resident Helped Convict Nazis

Dr. Arthur W. Fanta Prepared the Prosecution Against German Statesmen at War Trials

A Manchester resident, Dr. Arthur W. Fanta, of 24 Laurel place, prepared the prosecution against three of the Nazi German statesmen recently convicted for war crimes. Fanta, who is a doctor of law from Charles University in Prague, served as a reserve officer and was captured as a prisoner of war in 1918. He was held in the United States until 1921, when he returned to his native country. He then decided to re-enter the legal profession and with the aid of connections he developed, he started as an international attorney in Karlsruhe in 1924. He soon opened an office also in Prague, and had shortly become a professional member of the bar.

Head Leading Trial

As prosecutor and head of the prosecution, Dr. Fanta held a leading part in the questioning and examination of accused war criminals, and because of his extensive knowledge of European law and his part in Czechoslovak public life, he was one of the most important figures in the trial. He was the only lawyer who actually prosecuted the Nazis who had a part in the conviction of the "high-ups." Dr. Fanta's family—his mother, brother and his sister—were "simply vanished from the earth" during the Nazi occupation of his country, he said. He said he had seen the bodies of his wife and two children, but they were not, or at least he did not know, any lighter than when he saw them.

Dr. Fanta himself, a leading member of the pre-war Social-Democratic party in Czechoslovakia, was rounded by the Nazis until he fled for his life just before the invasion of Poland. His law office was established in Karlsruhe, in the southwestern part of Germany, and he saw developments at first hand from the very outset.

Now he is engaged in lecturing here on his unusual experience. He speaks with authority for his long experience as an international industrial lawyer he has dealings with large firms in all of Europe, with their governments, including the Russian—and he was in political life as well, having served as his party's legal advisor and representative. A close collaborator with the former Czechoslovak government-in-exile, he stated that he broke with it when, after the war, his country failed to recognize the friendship treaty with Russia.

Seen No Difference

"I have seen Nazism and Communism at immediate hand for many years," Dr. Fanta said. "There is no difference. If you believe you could deal with Communism, you must believe you could deal with Nazism. I must emphasize there is no difference."

Russia, Dr. Fanta says, is promoting one of the most impulsive and most imperialistic nationalisms ever to rise in history. Only, he says, Communism has the advantage of using its ideology as a mask to conceal its true intentions. He stated that the setting up of a satellite of being able to promote wholesale treason under the guise of a political-social movement.

Dr. Fanta says that the thoroughness of the Nazi preparations for war and eventual developments is almost unbelievable. He has a paper in which the possible necessity of the bombardment of other nations to this act, and gives the explanations that should be made to each nation involved. Everything the Nazis planned, was similarly criminally prepared, he says.

During his 5 1/2 years' service with the Army he was assistant director of anesthesia at the Metropolitan hospital in New York City before coming to Manchester Memorial hospital two years ago.

Dr. Pini said that he found himself out of sympathy with his own government after it signed his post war Russian pact, and he returned to return. He denounced his Czechoslovakian citizenship and now has a United Nations passport.

Thelma Masaryk, a suicide victim of the Gestapo, Dr. Pini said that he believes the only way to employ an anesthetist in the family of a friend, a doctor who had a wife and two daughters.

Address Given By Judge Shea

Speaks at Communion Breakfast of Campbell Council, K. of C.

The great words of the preamble to the Declaration of Independence mean much to us as Catholics—more than many of us will acknowledge. Superior Court Judge William J. Shea told members of Campbell Council, Knights of Columbus, at the annual Communion breakfast of the organization at St. Bridget's hall yesterday morning. Judge Shea substituted as principal speaker at the breakfast for Louis Kovar, representative of the supreme council, who was ill and unable to attend.

In opening his talk Judge Shea paid tribute to the past grand knights of the council, who were honored guests for the communion breakfast at the hall at the breakfast which was followed. More than 200 attendees were present. "In a large measure," said Judge Shea, "the standing of the council is due to the efforts of these men. It is a splendid thing to give them this recognition."

Today you have engaged in a religious act of faith that not only the people of St. Bridget's but the people of the whole diocese should become aroused by your showing your faith in God your Creator."

Cites an Incident

Judge Shea told of a recent conversation with one of the leading citizens of the state, an Episcopalian in which the talk centered around the subject of Communism. This man, who has occupied high offices in the state, said that often after attendance at the one church on Sunday he would go out of his way to pass a Catholic church to see the women who went "to demonstrate their belief in the Divine Master."

Living in Unusual Era

"We live in a most unusual time," Judge Shea said, "when the world is going through a period of great crisis. We are living in a time when the solution of these crises America leads the way. It is upon this country that the future of the world depends."

Justice Safeguard of Liberty

"If we are to make comparisons," Judge Shea said, "only a short time ago we saw the trial of the great Cardinal Minderichy by a nation and country that had the temerity and audacity to charge him with treason. That trial was a travesty on justice."

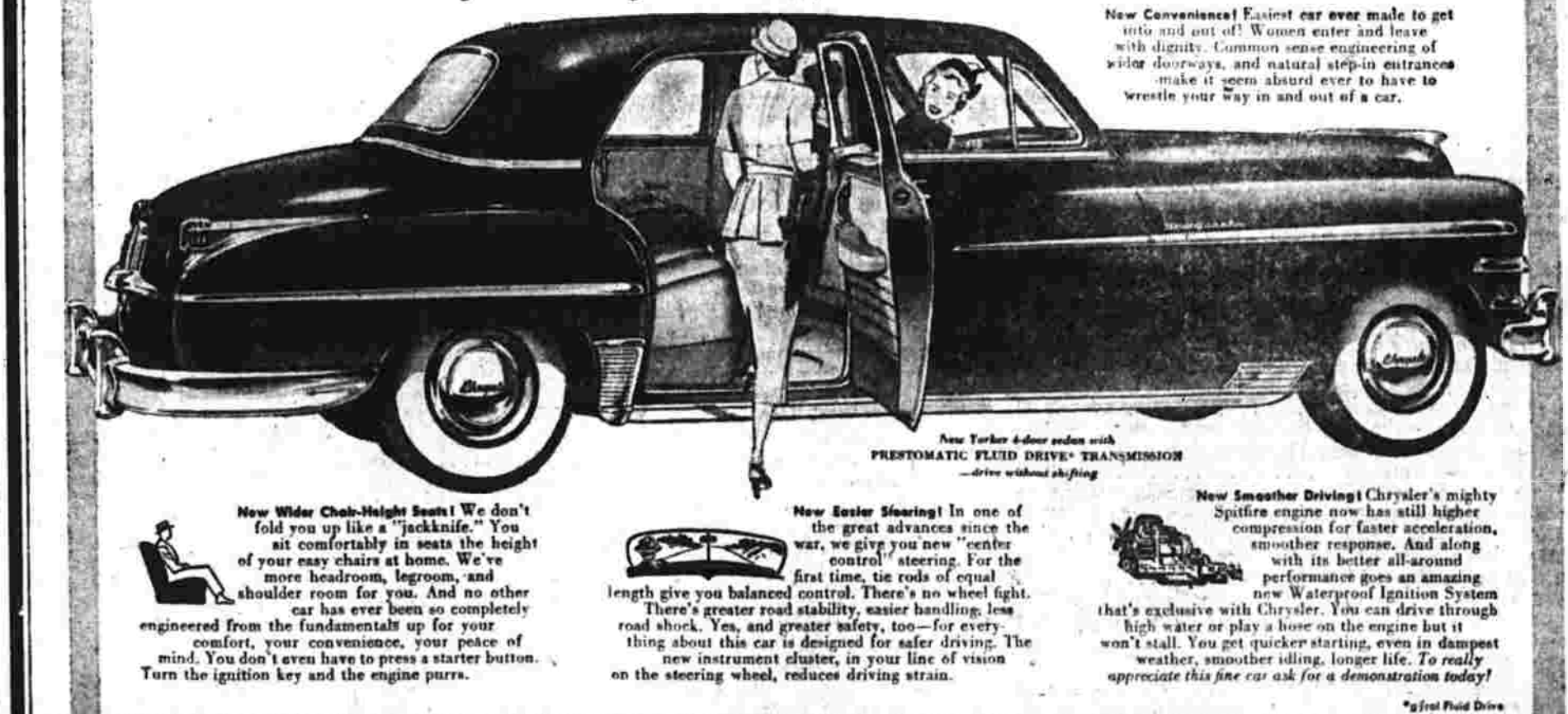
