### No Water Rate Change For Fire District Here

Directors Empower the General Manager to Continue Service at the Present Rate

The Board of Directors, after consideration last night voted that there should be no change in the water rate charged the South Manchester Fire District. The board also empowered the general manager to continue water service to the fire district at the same rate that has been in force for the past 25 years during which time the cost to the district was covered by contract. There will be no contract under the present scheme after the old agreement expires in July.

Constituents of the fire district appeared last night to urge that there be a reduction from the one cent per foot inch plus \$10 per hydrant charge. The board voted to reduce the rate to one-half cent per foot inch and only on pipe six inches and under in diameter. The present rate covers four inches and up.

Asked for Adjustment. The petitioners said that according to their investigation, the fire district is not getting its share of the water works. The water works is far above that made elsewhere, and that an adjustment should be made.

Large Bond Repayment. Waddell also noted that a large bond repayment will fall due on the water works in 1954. He said that it could not be reduced at a time when more funds are required. The outstanding bonds of the water department, which are per cent compared with the 1.6 per cent interest rate on bonds recently sold by the town. Waddell said he has tried to refinance this debt, but without success.

Members of Bolton PTA and parents of school children have received in the mail a questionnaire in which the Executive Committee of the Bolton unit will determine the amount of support the townpeople will give a hot lunch program in the new school.

"If you have been in the new school in Bolton, you have seen the cafeteria. It is just waiting for someone to take over and start preparing lunches for our children. We of the PTA Executive Committee would like to make that possible but we need your help."

"We have been supplying milk for the school children, now we would like to take advantage of our cafeteria and start a 'school lunch' program. This lunch would conform to the federal 'Type A' lunch pattern which will provide one-third of a child's daily food needs of protein, vitamins and minerals. It will include 3 ounces of meat or its equal, 2 1/2 ounces of vegetables or fruit, 1 slice of bread, 2 teaspoons of butter or margarine and 1-2 pint of whole milk."

"The Board of Education is doing its share. It has ordered two stoves and a refrigerator and has set aside money for chairs, tables and pomsby some small equipment such as pots, pans and cutlery. However, it will be necessary for the PTA to furnish the rest of the equipment, dishes and silverware either by soliciting financial aid or the actual items. We may also have to call on the community to support various fund-raising activities."

"It is hoped that should the PTA undertake the project of providing hot lunches for the school children, at least one aided helper may be obtained. In addition, there will be need of two volunteer helpers each day. Usually these helpers work a half-day a week for a period of two months."

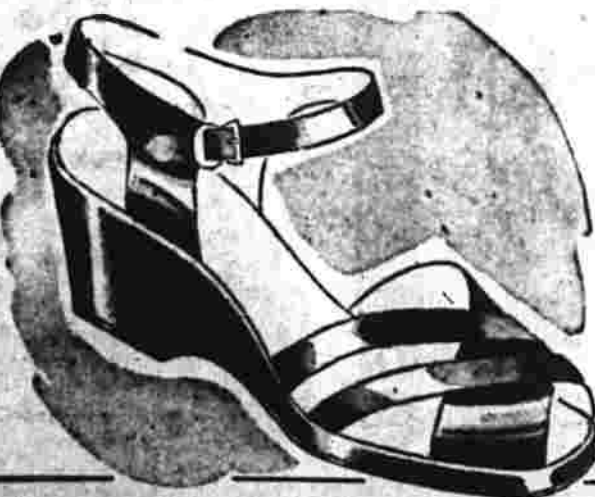
