**Conway Ready To Hold Talks**

**Door to Compromise in Assembly Held Ajar By House Leader**

Hartford, May 24 (AP)—The door to compromise in the stricken General Assembly was held ajar today by Rep. George E. Conway, (D-Guilford), a House majority leader.

Conway, target of severe criticism by Gov. Chester Bowles and other Democratic leaders, disclosed a compromise training program were approved by voice vote. The other three measures were approved in roll call votes, with most Republicans in opposition.

The other bills approved proposed: Maximum payment of \$15 a week for rehabilitation to a worker who suffers injuries making him unfit for his usual job. Approved 21-18.

Payment of unemployment insurance to workers who, after being claimants for benefits, become unemployed in opposition to a Republican bill to the foot of the calendar.

As soon as the majority in the Senate stop acting like children with their feet of the calendar strategy," said Conway, "we can discuss matters with them."

Conway said publication of the Republican legislative program left "no doubt as to exactly where we stand."

"We've been waiting for a reasonable program from the Democrats," he added. "So far we've found none at all."

If the Democrats are really sincere in a willingness to talk things over in a give-and-take spirit, said Conway, there's no reason why leaders of the two parties can't get together—once the Senate abandons its foot of the calendar technique.

The talk of compromise came as the Legislature headed into the home-stretch of the session, with only 15 days to go before constitutional deadlines for adjournment.
