General Assembly Votes \$250,000 for Teacher Program

Hartford, May 27.—The General Assembly today approved a \$250,000 appropriation for an emergency teacher training program. As the bill went through to final passage yesterday, however, there came an indication that Connecticut, for next fall at least, may have a surplus, instead of a shortage of elementary school teachers. The emergency training program was advocated early in the legislative session when the state Department of Education estimated there would be at least 850 vacancies in elementary school jobs next fall.

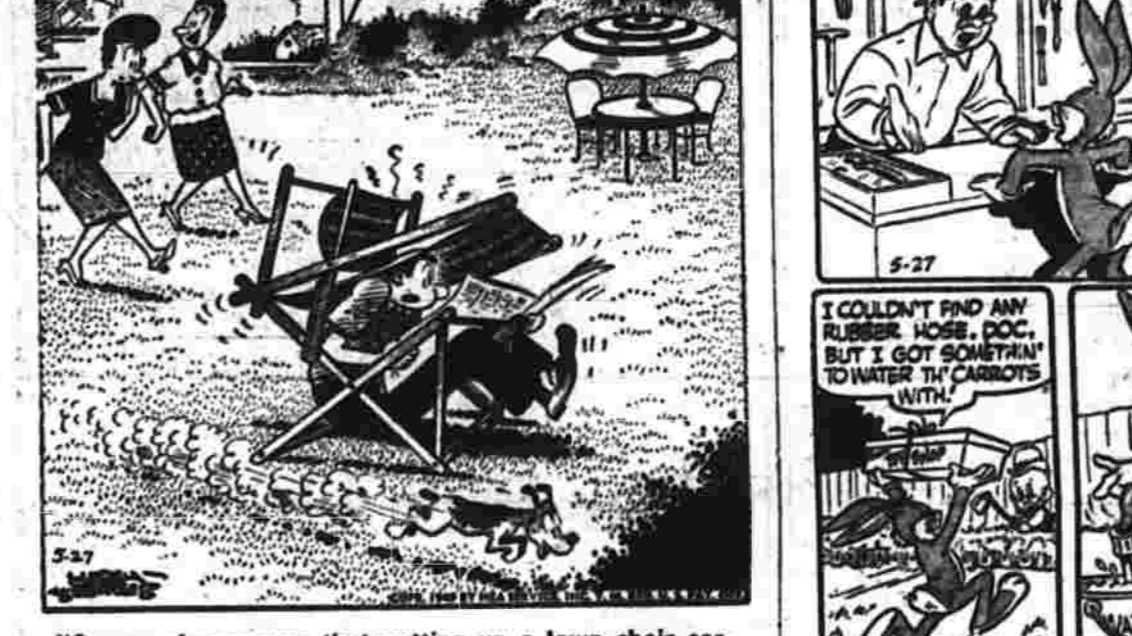

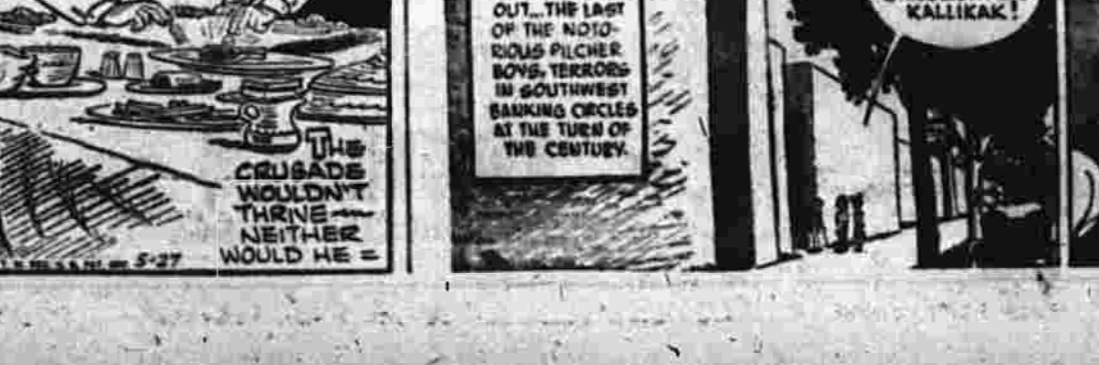

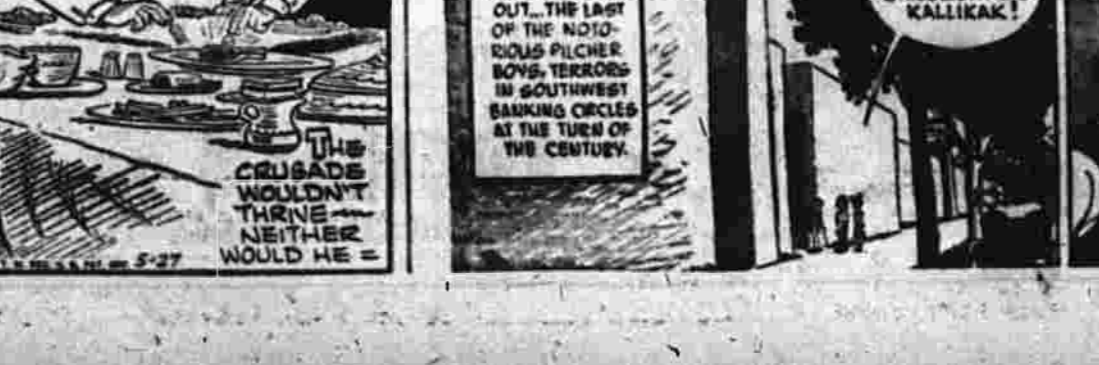
