Manchester, May 28.—(AP)—Way back in January when Gov. Chester Bowles delivered the inaugural address he expressed confidence there were "areas of agreement" between Republicans and Democrats in the General Assembly.

Today, with only 12 days remaining in the session, the Democratic-controlled Senate and the Republican-controlled House and their leaders are sitting down to discuss the "areas of agreement" which the governor said existed on the day he took office.

The talk of compromise, noticeable in the Legislature in recent days, grew louder yesterday before the legislators were to meet for a session on the Memorial Day holiday.

In the Senate, Majority Leader Alfred F. Wechsler expressed a mood of compromise in his opening address to the body.

On the contrary, Wechsler said he wanted Republicans to be "waxed" with "tempers in control" and "no compromise" in the House.
