Much Trouble Is Reported Concerning Septic Tanks

Many institutions, schools, camps, boarding houses, gasoline service stations and private residences have reported trouble with their septic disposal systems because too few people know enough about septic tanks and sewage systems, said J. Harry L. Giles, sanitary engineer in the Connecticut State Department of Health.

Successful operation of a septic disposal system requires that the owner or person in charge know the size and location of the septic tank, how many persons it is intended to serve, the submergence of the inlet and outlet, how often it should be cleaned, date of last cleaning, and how to dispose of the septic tank effluent.

It is important that the septic tank be large enough for the job expected of it. Minimum liquid capacity of any septic tank must be 500 gallons. Actual size is determined by the type of service and the number of persons served.

Knowledge of the tank's location will save time and trouble. Regular inspections should be made with particular attention to the submergence of inlet and outlet pipes in order to check the system against clogging.

As a general rule, septic tanks of proper size to capacity should be cleaned at least every three to four years. Tanks for restaurants,
