Boomerang Tide

In international politics, as well as in domestic economies, there is an age in which good news also always seems to be bad news.

Strategically speaking, the best news the world had all day long was the fact that Yugoslavia's Marshal Tito has declared his country's neutrality. This, in itself, was good news, for almost a year now, an apparent success of defying Moscow and traveling his own road.

There is more good news, this week, from Bulgaria, where former Vice Premier Traicho Kostov is the latest purger from Bulgaria's Communist ranks. The purge which has been taking place in Bulgaria is good news for the West because it shows the present course of a faction which is anxious to cut loose from Moscow's apron strings.

There is good news in the fact that the portrait of Stalin has not yet appeared anywhere in the wake of the Chinese Communist armies, although Chinese Communists have time enough to make poster portraits of their own native leaders.

All this news is good because it reveals a tendency on the part of agents of the supposed Russian empire of influence to break away from Moscow and pursue their own destinies.

Now, at the same time, it is bad news? It is bad news because the portrait of Tito, or the portrait of the Bulgarian purger, or the portrait of the Chinese Communist leaders with Stalin and with Russia is not a portrait of a nationalist impetus. Tito wants to be a Communist, but he wants to be a Yugoslav Communist. The Bulgarian purger has nothing against Communism; he merely wants to be sure that Bulgaria is an independent Communist nation. The Chinese Communists do not repudiate Communist theory; they merely wish to establish a "China for the Chinese."

The thing that is weakening Moscow, then, is the rise and recurrence of individual nationalisms. That is good, as it weakens Moscow. But it is bad as one looks to the future, and applies against that future the kind of history extreme nationalism has always produced in the past. The world wheat agreement is particularly significant because it involves recognition of the possibility that there is any solution of our difficulties in trying to maintain an economy of abundance, that solution lies in a world economic rather than in a national economic concept. If we look for our solution in the future, there are millions of people in the world ready and willing to consume it. So long as this condition exists, there is a possibility that we can solve our own national problem of abundance by merging our economy with a whole world in which abundance is still dominant. This is not, of course, a true solution of the problem of abundance. Eventually the whole world will be in a state of abundance, as it is in progress, come into the state of productive power into ourselves now enjoy, and then the problem of abundance will rise up again, this time in world terms.

But until that time the problem of abundance, in national terms, can be outwitted, and some stability be achieved during the long span of time in which the world approaches its goal of enough for all. The world wheat agreement is an experimental step in this direction.

Truman on Hysteria

President Truman's expanded discussion, in his press conference, of the wave of hysteria now sweeping the nation, was a healthy discussion, and one which leads, in some degree, to speed the day when we shall map out in order to it and regain our mental and emotional balance.

The President was entirely, mournfully correct, in noting the historical parallels, which are that, in the wake of every great national crisis, there comes a period when we go witch-hunting among ourselves and adopt laws and interpret existing laws in order to ban that very freedom of speech and thought upon which our nation is founded.

The President is also correct in his notation that the country survived such periods of hysteria, emerging with its own principles restored to honor.

All this, unfortunately, is of small consolation to those who are the victims of this hysteria when it is at its peak. There have been deaths of men we would call relatively innocent in any normal period of our history; reputations have been damaged which did not really deserve damage; careers have been injured which would normally continue to be honorable.

When we go on one of these hysteria binges, we use a scatter-gun; our attack and prosecution is not confined to those who might fairly be considered guilty; many or all of these might really be considered innocent.

It is good to know that some day, as they pass, we will relax from our present suspicion of ourselves. The hope must be that the day does come soon, and that meanwhile the health and progress grows more restrained and accurate.

New Haven, June 17.—(AP)—A Worcester, Mass., man, convicted by an Army court martial on charges of black marketeering in Casablanca, has lost his bid for release from the Federal Correctional Institution at Danbury.
