





Russia has lost little time in labeling President Truman's Point Four Program. The President's program is, according to "Red Star," nothing more or less than "American colonialism."

Our national conscience is already troubled because we released the world's first atomic bomb. The President Truman is sending a message to Congress on Friday, asking \$45,000,000 for the start of the Point Four Program for aid to the economically underdeveloped areas of the world.

With many of the economically underdeveloped areas of the world, aid is not a new thing. We have long had ties of trade and commerce. In many instances today we greatly need the products of their labor and resources.

To be sure, Point Four, if it gets working, is going to benefit us. To be sure, there is a strong element of help others, help ourselves, in it. And to be sure, all our good intentions about helping the benefit to ourselves on a reasonable basis, free from exploitation in our own favor, are going to need close watching.

The fact remains that, in this policy, the United States is taking an intelligent, constructive view of its own mission in the world. The fact remains that, in trying to contribute toward the building of a peaceful, stable world, and that the method it has selected is the soundest of all possible methods toward that objective.
