Name Chosen For New Bank

Proposed New Institution Also Secures an Option for the Site

Formal announcement was made this morning that the town's proposed new bank will be known as the First National Bank of Manchester, and that an option has been secured for a building site at 200 Main street as the site of the business. It also was stated by John E. G. Robinson, secretary of the organization committee, that opening of the bank will be deferred until it can start business with deposits of \$100,000.

At the present time, indicated deposits are above \$375,000. In order that the start of operations may be hastened, Robinson said, the organization committee will file estimates of their intended deposits with the law firm of Loomis and Robinson, which is counsel for the organization committee, or with any member of that committee.

Monday, Rother said, Chairman William B. Rogers of the committee, Saul M. Silverstein, its vice chairman, and Secretary Robinson and Attorney George C. Loomis conferred in Bolton with Michael Hurley, chief National Bank examiner. They reported subscription lists and other information, and that deposits so far indicated amount to \$575,000. Developments, Rother said, are very favorable, and with the bank site now secured, it is expected that the remainder of the details will be rapidly worked out.

Description of Property. The property on which option papers today were filed consists of a single story brick structure adjoining the Hotel Sheridan, 20 feet by 100 feet, at Main and Hazel streets. The building is 20 feet from the 110 foot street. The lot is 50 by 90 feet.

Drive-In-Teller-Window. A special feature of the proposed alteration of the building for bank purposes will be a "drive-in-teller-window," featured in many new banking houses. The necessary vault and other equipment will be installed at the same time as the property transfer is completed.

Announcement of the opening of the bank has not been made until after the meeting of the Board of Directors at which present members of the organization committee will be available to answer questions. **Bird Hanged For Murder**

**Pronounced Dead 14 Minutes After Trap Is Sprung at Walla Walla**

Walla Walla, Wash., July 15.—(AP)—A bird, who hatched a trial of slaughter across the country, died on the gallows of a Washington state penitentiary at 12:30 a. m. (p. m. l.) today. He was hanged for the murder of Mrs. Bertha Knott Oct. 30, 1947, in Tacoma, Wash.

The trap was sprung at 12:05, fourteen minutes later Dr. Elmer Hill, prison physician, pronounced the 46-year-old Negro dead. Bird appeared to be fairly calm.

Atlanta, July 15.—(AP)—A flaming cross was set off in the yard and four bullets were fired last night into a residence occupied by two young attorneys who filed an injunction suit against the Ku Klux Klan.

**Heart Ailment Proves Fatal**

Oakland, Calif., July 15.—(AP)—Walter Morrow, 84, widely-known newspaperman, died last night of a heart ailment.

Morrow started newspaper work as a cub reporter for the Daily Evening News in 1893. Twenty years later he became editor-in-chief of the south-western group of Scripps-owned newspapers.

His last newspaper job was editor of the Columbus, Ohio, Citizen in 1942. He later became manager of the American Retailer, a publication in Washington.

During depression days, he conducted what he called the Morrow plan—a parody on the pension plan—whereby he paid himself "thirty dollars every Thursday." Morrow's own slogan was "retire at birth."

After the war, Morrow said his "plan" could not begin to compete with some theories seriously advanced to cure post-war economic ills.
