No New Cases Of Polio Here

Dr. Keeney Expresses Confidence That Outbreak is Under Control

Confidence that the local outbreak of poliomyelitis which has been termed an "endemic" rather than epidemic would remain under control" was expressed today by Dr. Robert R. Keeney, Jr., town health officer.

An "epidemic" endemic outbreak of the local variety, Dr. Keeney said, would be expected to run its course in from four to six weeks. He indicated that Manchester would have to expect some additional cases before the disease would be under control. But he stressed that the outbreak was not a regular poliomyelitis, which he said is still scheduled to arrive in August.

Dr. Keeney also emphasized the fact that, except for one fatality, the great majority of cases reported here have been mild and are responding excellently to treatment.
