Numbers of Idle Above 1942 Level As Labor Grows

Figures Show Paradox Of New High in Employment; Explained By Fact That Workers Have Increased Along With Jobs

Washington, Aug. 3.—(P)—Unemployment rose above 4,000,000 in July for the first time since January, 1942, the Census bureau reported today. But the number of employed also increased, registering in July the highest figure—50,720,000—for 1948.

Reason for the simultaneous increase in employment and unemployment was an increase of 1,000,000 in the civilian labor force—the number having jobs or seeking them.

One in Four Gets Job Only one of each four of the new job seekers managed to find a job in July, the census said. The number of unemployed in July was 4,000,000, up from 3,770,000 in June and 3,237,000 in July of last year.

The 50,720,000 employed in July compared with 38,610,000 in June, and 31,610,000 in July, 1947. At almost the same time the figures were released, the American Bankers Association told Senators there is no danger of a real depression, and that business is in fact showing a pickup.

Earl R. Muir, president of the Louisville, Ky., Trust company, said there is no real depression when we have in the hands of the nation's banks a total of \$100,000,000 in savings and deposits.

"We are going through a very fine period of readjustment," Muir told a Banking Conference in New York today. "We are getting better productivity from labor which is doing a better job of doing the same work."
