Charity Costs Levelling Off

Increase of Only \$18.36 in July Over Previous Month Here

The draft on town welfare funds is shown by a comparison between the amount expended in July of a year ago, \$46,257, and the outgo last month which was \$57,113. However, there are signs that the current increase is leveling off, for in July the expense was only \$18.36 more than for June. The number of cases aided for the past two months has remained the same, at 73, but due to the indifference in size of families, there were only 104 persons helped in July as compared with 111 persons in June. The fact that while the number of persons aided decreased slightly from June to July, while the cost of aid rose a small amount, is accounted for by various factors, such as medical assistance, which makes it difficult to tie in costs directly with the welfare population.

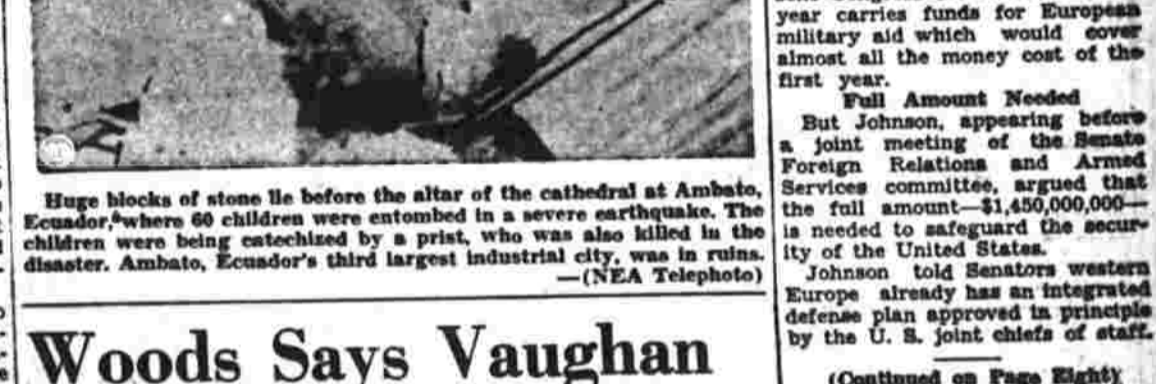
