London, Aug. 10 — (P) —
Albania said today she is being invaded by Greece and that fighting is in progress along a 30-mile front. A broadcast by the official Tirana radio said bloody clashes with Athens government troops began four days ago. It added that hundreds of Greek soldiers have been killed or taken prisoner.

A spokesman for the Greek information service in London said "there is certainly no invasion." He said the Albanian report probably referred to the new offensive launched by the Greek Army against the Communist-led guerrillas in the Grammos mountain area not far from the Albanian border.
