Doctor's Talk Aid to Police

Brings Steel Worker Out of Barricaded House; Woman Dead

Shelton, Conn., Aug. 12.—(AP) —The quiet, persuasive voice of a Tacoma doctor early today talked a rampaging steel worker out of a barricaded house after the death and mutilation of his woman companion.

Fourteen peace officers, using tear gas and billy clubs, had faced in a three-hour effort to bring him out.

The steel worker is John Davis, 40, and the dead woman was identified tentatively as Mrs. Arlene Stone, 47, both of Tacoma.

Davis was brought held in the Pierce county jail. Officers said Davis was being held immediately after questioning.

Peace officers said Davis was held in the jail until he was taken to a hospital.

Deputy Sheriff Brut Milston and Russell Will said Davis wife told this story.

Davis and the woman came to the residence at 7 p. m. last night. Both were intoxicated, Davis ordered the woman to get out. Watching from a window, Mrs. Davis said, she saw the couple in a first-rate bing and Davis was trying to force the woman to get out. The officers quoted Mrs. Davis as saying the woman began to sob violently after Davis uttered physical intimacies. He called the sheriff officers to help.
