Balky Miner May Get Aid
 Pension Promised to Livengood for His Disfranchisement of Lewis
 Untonctown, Pa., Oct. 7.—(AP)—That ex-convict miner who used the United Mine Workers welfare fund and then was tossed out of the union may get his disability pension, anyway.
 In fact, if the UMW fund benefits remain suspended, he may be the only coal miner to get a pension.
 The miner, George H. Livengood, 54, held a press conference last night and displayed a telegram from Norfolk, Va.
 The wire read: "A mine worker who was dismissed from your union because of his criminal record is now applying for a pension. It will give the pension of which he was deprived."
 It was signed "H. Lee Page."
 Livengood says he does not know Page and has not yet investigated whether it is a genuine offer.
 Livengood died a Federal District court suit in Washington, D. C., September 22 in which he sued removal of the welfare fund's trust and an annual audit of the fund.
 A few days ago Local 6308 near Untonctown cancelled Livengood's membership on the ground that he had taken court action against the union first at his own expense to the union.

**Security Program
 Lauded by Bowles**

Hartford, Oct. 7.—Governor Bowles today lauded the passage of the new federal security program as a "major step towards giving our people a greater and much needed security in their lives."

The Democratic chief executive, in a statement issued yesterday, said he hoped the Senate would enact the measure "as soon as possible."

The social security bill would increase by 11,000,000 the number of persons eligible for benefits and would increase benefits by 70 percent or more.

The Navy's Case

The Navy-Air Force controversy has got out of hand, not primarily because of the program for defense unity, but because that program has been handled in such a way as to convince many Navy men that unified command is something certain to result in the progressive elimination of the Navy itself. The professed goal of unification is not to destroy the Navy but to bring its operation and management into efficient harmony with the operation and management of the other branches of the armed forces. But Navy men do not see it that way. They see the Air Force being all too successful in convincing defense heads that land planes can do everything in the next war; they see the prospect of the Navy being whittled down; they think they are not going to give their chance to serve their country.

The Old Truman Trick

President Truman Thursday was in form with his most famous trick, which is that of facing two ways on the issue of peace and disarmament.

The President's most justly famous performance took place in 1945, when, on the same day, he extolled the Golden Rule as the world's only salvation in one speech, and, in his next statement, denounced the atomic bomb as a symbol of America's power in the world.

Thursday's performance was a close second. With his pen hand, he signed the atomic bill, and signed the bill appropriating \$1,214,000,000 for arms aid to Europe, a sum which must be multiplied several times when one contemplates the actual cost in terms of their actual cost to the nation.
