Carol Paight Not Witness
Blonde College Student Fails to Testify at Slaying Inquest

Bridgeport, Oct. 11.—Carol Paight, 20-year-old blonde college student, of Stamford, who shot and killed her father, Sgt. Carl Paight, of the Stamford Police Department, September 23, in a slaying death from cancer, failed to testify today as Coroner Theodore W. Stecher conducted a five-minute inquest into the slaying and then returned decision.

The only witness examined by the coroner during the brief proceeding which was witnessed by a crowd which filled the small court room, was Sgt. John A. McInerney of the Stamford Police Department. He said he interviewed Carol after she shot her father as he lay in his hospital bed, and she told him she committed the act because she had been just informed that her parent was the victim of an honorable furlough.

King, an attorney, Sergeant McInerney testified that Carol told him she shot her father with his own service revolver after firing a practice shot at the range with the workings of the weapon.
